Re: Objection to SRBA Claim – Goldsmith (A37-12013)
By: Sun Valley Land and Mineral, Inc. (37-4100)

Dear Matt:

I am writing in behalf of Sun Valley Mineral Company relative to water rights in the Deer Creek area of Blaine County. It has recently come to my attention that there are two competing claims for a low temperature geothermal source near the Clarendon Resort on Deer Creek in Blaine County.

Sun Valley Land and Mineral Inc. filed a claim on water right number 37-4100 claiming a priority of 09/06/1956 for 0.78 cfs. for recreation.

Sun Valley Minerals Inc. predecessor (R.B. Randall and Chloe Randall) granted a lease on February 7, 1956 to Vernon W. Goldsmith whose wife is Jewel L. Goldsmith for use of a parcel of land. The lease specifically states that “—no right to the use of the water of said springs shall be created or established in any manner which shall be prior or paramount to the rights given the Leasee to make use of said water in the manner herein provided at any time during the term of this lease.” I believe that you have a copy of this lease agreement.

According to the IDWR water rights data base, the current listed owner of water right 37-4100 is Vernon W. Goldsmith. This ownership is incorrect since Mr. Goldsmith has no basis for ownership, only use of the water according to the agreement. The ownership should be changed to Sun Valley Land and Minerals Inc. as per the land ownership and agreement with Goldsmith.

Vernon Goldsmith filed a claim (A37-12013) for the use of this spring, claiming a priority of 07/01/1956 for 0.25 cfs for recreation.
