Source in T06S, R13E, S17, NENWNW is also known as Montana Mining Company Ditch Spring No. 11.

The facility volume for this right & Right 37-7712 shall not exceed 132,132 cubic feet.

This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than .02 cfs per acre nor more than 3.0 afa per acre for irrigation of the lands above.

Use of water under this right is subject to policies set forth in the State of Idaho Water Plan, including Policy No. 5G.

Measuring devices of a type approved by this Department shall be maintained at the point of diversion and point of effluent discharge.
