

FINDINGS OF FACT

Claims and Director's Report:

36-02356

Blue Lakes Trout Farm, Inc. (Blue Lakes), was granted leave to file its second amended notice of claim under 36-02356 on July 2, 1997. It claimed a total of 100 cfs from Alpheus Creek for fish propagation, domestic and commercial uses with a priority date of May 29, 1958, based on a license. In his *Amended Director's Report Regarding Claim to Water Right No. 36-02356*, dated July 7, 1997, the Director recommended the claim as filed. However, under the quantity element, the Director included the language -- facility volume 10.66 af. The Director also described the non-irrigation uses: "commercial/fish facility; domestic/2 homes; fish/49 ponds, hatch." The single contested issue in this and the other three subcases is whether facility volume should be decreed by the SRBA Court for fish propagation water rights.

36-07210

Blue Lakes filed its claim under 36-07210 claiming 45 cfs from Alpheus Creek for fish propagation with a priority date of November 17, 1971, based on a license. The Director recommended the claim as filed, but under remarks, the Director included the same language as before -- facility volume 10.66 af. The Director described the non-irrigation uses: "fish/49 ponds, 38 hatchery tanks."

Blue Lakes called as its only witness James E. Parsons, research and technical director for Blue Lakes Trout Farm. Clear Lakes called Harold Johnson, office manager of Idaho Trout Processors, the processing and sales company for trout raised at several hatcheries, including Clear Lakes, Rimview, Rainbow, White Springs and Fisheries Development.

At the close of trial, counsel for Blue Lakes and Clear Lakes asked to submit post-trial memoranda in lieu of closing argument. Blue Lakes lodged its *Post-Trial Memorandum* on September 15, 1997. Clear Lakes lodged its *Post-Trial Brief* on September 17, 1997.

TESTIMONY

David R. Tuthill, Jr.

Mr. Tuthill stated in his *Report* that IDWR recommended facility volume in fish propagation rights pursuant to I.C. §42-1411(2)(j) and I.C. §42-1411(2)(k).² *Report*, p. 2. Those provisions required:

The director shall determine the following elements, to the extent the director deems appropriate and proper, to define and administer the water rights acquired under state law:

...

- (j) conditions on the exercise of any water right included in any decree, license, or approved transfer application; and
- (k) such remarks and other matters as are necessary for definition of the right, for clarification of any element of a right, or for administration of the right by the director.

Given those duties, Mr. Tuthill essentially said the Director recommended facility volume for fish hatcheries to protect water quality and water quantity:

7. To the extent necessary to satisfy their rights, water right holders are entitled to the maintenance of both water quantity and quality on their water source as of the date of their appropriation of water.

² In 1997, I.C. §42-1411(2)(j) was amended to become I.C. §42-1411(2)(i). I.C. §42-1411(2)(k) is now I.C. §42-1411(2)(j).

original license or decree, we identify those three parameters at this point in the adjudication.

Reporter's Transcript, pp. 16-17.⁴

Mr. Tuthill could not think of any other use of water for which IDWR identified the quantity element three different ways. *Reporter's Transcript*, p. 18. He said IDWR decides what may or may not be necessary to define or administer a water right based on administrative experience:

So with fish propagation, for example, we found that quantification of rate of flow and volume diverted was not sufficient. So we added facility volume as a further quantification to resolve problems that had come up on Billingsley Creek.

Reporter's Transcript, pp. 19-20.

Later in his testimony, Mr. Tuthill agreed that disputes between fish propagators along Billingsley Creek actually concerned water quality rather than water quantity:

Well, the department for decades paid no attention to water quality. As a result of competition for rights in the Billingsley Creek area, in the Hagerman area, we began to look at impacts to water quality as affecting water rights, water quantity rights.

Reporter's Transcript, p. 42.⁵

Mr. Tuthill suggested that facility volume is necessary for future administration:

It's my understanding that in the SRBA we need to provide attributes to the water rights that define extent of beneficial use. Now, if a water right changes over time, then one needs to be able to go back and see what water right was originally decreed.... Does that mean that we're measuring water quality within the department of water resources? No. It means that we're defining the water right so that if

⁴ IDWR's goal is to include facility volume in all fish propagation rights, both existing and future. *Reporter's Transcript*, p. 155.

⁵ The following discussion took place near the end of Mr. Tuthill's testimony:

THE COURT: Well, if you're concerned about water quality with fish facilities, does that concern for quality apply to any other users other than fish propagators?

A. Historically, other uses that have negative impact on quality would be irrigation. And in most cases an irrigation return flow is still acceptable for further irrigation. So it hasn't been a show stopper for other irrigation rights.

Industrial and commercial uses that have a high impact on water quality are often totally consumptive relative to the source. They either treat the water or land [?] apply it or do something different.

Fish propagation is the one use where return flow has affected other users to the point of being problematic from a water delivery standpoint, the quality of return flow.

Reporter's Transcript, p. 154.

A. We would solicit input from DEQ; however, we could not delegate our responsibility to DEQ because it's a responsibility attributed to the department of water resources.

Q. Has the department of water resources in its rules adopted any standards or rules with respect to water quality?

A. There are rules relative to water appropriation, water allocation, appropriation of new water rights which define local public interest. And in that they define the water quality. But specific water quality parameter rules have not been adopted.

Reporter's Transcript, pp. 79-80.

Mr. Tuthill said that facility volume "incorporates a storage component." However, he conceded that by its own "rule of thumb," IDWR will not specify a storage right if the facility will not fill in a day. *Reporter's Transcript*, pp. 105-108. So, where a facility like Blue Lakes turns over water many times each day from a direct flow right, it is not considered a storage right.

On April 3, 1997, IDWR called a meeting of fish propagators in Basin 36 in Buhl. The purpose of the meeting was "to discuss 'facility volume' parameter of a water right with a fish propagation use." In the notice of the meeting, IDWR said it was "open to the discussion of alternative mechanisms for quantifying the water quality impacts of fish propagation facilities, to enable proper protection for and distribution of water rights." Blue Lakes Exhibit 6. Of the twenty people who attended the meeting, all who spoke opposed inclusion of facility volume. *Reporter's Transcript*, p. 24, and Blue Lakes Exhibit 9.⁷

James E. Parsons

Mr. Parsons, research and technical director at Blue Lakes Trout Farm, said they have no current plans to expand their facilities. Before any facility could be expanded, Blue Lakes would

⁷ On April 21, 1997, Idaho Fish and Game wrote to IDWR in opposition to facility volume parameter for fish propagation water rights. Fish and Game was concerned because it was changing the way it managed its conservation hatcheries and that meant changing facility configurations and rearing volumes. Fish and Game also had a suggestion:

It appears the major rationale for considering facility volume to limit a fish propagation water right is to prevent degradation of water quality to a downstream water user. IDFG suggests using the NPDES [National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System] Discharge Monitoring Report criteria... These parameters are flow related and measure the net impact any hatchery has on the water quality of a stream. Since the permits are based on the net change in these water quality parameters, changes to an upstream facility would not necessarily result in a downstream facility being unable to meet NPDES permit requirements.

Blue Lakes Exhibit 8.

Mr. Johnson views IDWR's efforts to impose facility volume on fish propagators as an effort by state agencies to micro-manage private business.

Mr. Johnson said both the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and DEQ have taken the position of no net increase of nutrients for the middle reach of the Snake River between Milner Dam and King Hill. That includes the area of Blue Lakes' and Clear Springs' hatcheries. It is part of the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) process to reduce nuisance aquatic growth in the mid-Snake River.

Mr. Johnson said there are no disputes about water quality between fish propagators along Billingsley Creek.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

I.C. §42-1411(4)

The Director's recommendations of water right claims are entitled to *prima facie* weight:

The director shall file the director's report with the district court, and the director's report shall be a part of the record. Upon filing with the court, the director's report, except for the explanatory material referred to in subsection (1) of this section, shall constitute prima facie evidence of the nature and extent of the water rights acquired under state law. The unobjected to portions of the director's report shall be decreed as reported.

I.C. §42-1411(4).⁹

Idaho's Supreme Court has approved this statutory presumption and explained how it works:

The Legislature's direction that the contents of the Director's report shall constitute prima facie evidence of some water right claims was a permissible exercise of the authority, recognized in I.R.E. 301, to create an evidentiary presumption. Unless that evidentiary presumption is overcome by the evidence or the application of that presumption is clearly erroneous on its face, the facts set forth in the Director's report are established.

In Re SRBA Case No. 39576, 128 Idaho 246, 256, 912 P.2d 614, 624 (1995).

⁹ There was no argument that facility volume might be "explanatory material," probably because of how the Legislature defined the term:

The director may include such explanatory material as he deems appropriate in the director's report. Such explanatory material shall not impose any conditions or restrictions on the rights reported and shall not be subject to objection. This explanatory material shall not be used to support any notice of claim, objection to a notice of claim, or response to an objection.

I.C. §42-1411(1).

ground water. Mr. Tuthill was obviously concerned over delivery of water (quantity) when he mentioned the SRBA Court's decision in *Musser*.¹⁰ *Reporter's Transcript*, p. 157.

But as much as Mr. Tuthill and IDWR were concerned about water quantity, they were far more concerned about water quality. During Mr. Tuthill's cross-examination, *Shokal v. Dunn* was mentioned no fewer than 13 times. He agreed that water quality was the primary concern when he prepared his *Report* before trial. *Reporter's Transcript*, p. 77.

As IDWR has struggled with administrative provisions, it looked for tools to help in their efforts. In 1979, IDWR first adopted facility volume to help solve water quality disputes between fish propagators in the Billingsley Creek area. Mr. Tuthill personally drafted IDWR's 1979 "Administrator's Memorandum." Blue Lakes Exhibit 14 and *Reporter's Transcript*, pp. 7-8. The Memorandum required that facility volume be included in construction plans for all fish propagation applications for 1 cfs or greater.

While water quality along Billingsley Creek may have been a contested issue in 1979, none of those fish hatcheries now see it as a problem. In fact, they oppose any facility volume provision in their decrees because the NPDES Discharge Monitoring Report criteria and DEQ's Water Quality Standards and Wastewater Treatment Requirements protect water quality. The hatcheries view facility volume in water right decrees as duplicative and counter-productive. The fact is that whether IDWR includes facility volume in permits and licenses or the SRBA Court decrees facility volume, hatcheries must still meet EPA and DEQ water quality standards. Those are the same standards IDWR would apply before approving any facility enlargement because IDWR has no water quality standards.

The main concern with including facility volume in fish propagation water rights is that the term is amorphous. Mr. Tuthill said that facility volume "cuts across three different areas-- quantity, nature of use and place of use." *Reporter's Transcript*, p. 103. For that reason, it is virtually impossible to conclude that facility volume is necessary for definition or clarification of any element of a right or for administration of a right. It should be no surprise that Mr. Tuthill called facility volume a "parameter":

volume may be a useful tool, but it is not necessary for definition or clarification of Blue Lakes' rights or for efficient administration of the rights by the Director.

Post-Trial Proceedings

A *Preliminary Report & Recommendation and Order* was filed on October 22, 1997. Because no one then filed a motion to alter or amend, a single *Special Master's Report* with separate *Special Master's Recommendations* for 36-02356, 36-07210, 36-07427 and 36-07720 was filed on November 25, 1997.

However, on December 16, 1997, Blue Lakes filed a *Motion to Alter or Amend* in 36-02356 only. Blue Lakes sought to increase the annual volume for domestic use and proportionately increase the total annual volume for the right. On March 10, 1998, the *Order Granting Motion to Alter or Amend* was entered allowing the higher amounts in 36-02356. The other three claims remained unchanged.

Conclusion

Blue Lakes Trout Farm, Inc., is entitled to partial decrees adjudicating its water rights under claims 36-02356, 36-07210, 36-07427 and 36-07720 as described in the attached *Special Master's Recommendations for Partial Decrees for Water Rights 36-02356, 36-07210, 36-07427 and 36-07720*.

We are in receipt of the Notices of Error filed on the above referenced claims. We are not making any changes to the recommendations at this time.

There were three issues raised on the above referenced Notices of Errors. These issues were: Non-irrigation uses; Remarks; and Place of Use. A review of the files did not uncover any discrepancies in the place of use recommended for each of the SRBA claims. If you have specific information regarding an error, please forward that information by October 13, 1992 and we will review the files again.

Regarding the Non-irrigation uses and Remarks, I spoke with you on the phone and you stated that the issue was specifically the ponds described in the Non-irrigation uses and the facility volume identified in the Remarks. Based on our understanding of the law, the facility volume (determined by the ponds) associated with the priority date of a water right is an essential element of that right. We have used our records and available information to determine the facility volumes for each water right. If you feel there is an error, please forward supporting documents to this office by October 13, 1992 and we will review the information.

If you still do not agree with the proposed IDWR recommendation to the court, you may file an objection with the court after you receive the final recommendation or your water right. Information about the objection process will be included when the final recommendation is received.
