) **ORDER VACATING MANDATORY  
SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE and  
SETTING STATUS CONFERENCE**

On May 3, 1993, the Idaho Conservation League, Inc., Idaho Rivers United, Inc., Idaho Wildlife Federation, Inc., and Northwest Resource Information Center, Inc. ("Conservation Groups") filed their *Motion for Leave to Intervene* in Case No. 39576.

On January 14, 1994, Presiding Judge Daniel C. Hurlbutt entered his *Order Granting, in Limited Part, Motion to Reconsider Order Denying Motion for Leave to Intervene*. An appeal from that order is currently pending before the Idaho Supreme Court.

On February 25, 1994, the Conservation Groups filed their *Amended Motion for Leave to Intervene* in Subcase Nos. 36-02080 and 36-15127 and lodged *Amended Objections* in the two subcases.

On December 22, 1994, the Magic Valley Underground Pumpers Association, Inc., and each of the Association's individual members ("Magic Valley") filed its *Motion for Leave to File Late Objection and Memorandum in Support* in Subcase No. 36-02080.

On May 8, 1995, the United States (claimant) and the A & B Irrigation District (an objector) filed their *Stipulation to Vacate Settlement Conference*. The *Stipulation* states that Magic Valley have no objection and the State of Idaho, IDWR, agrees to vacating the settlement conference and staying the matter "until final adjudication of the amnesty provisions issues. Alternatively, the claimant and objector request that the Court vacate the settlement conference

until the issues of parties are resolved and set for a briefing and hearing schedule to resolve each of these issues." There is no indication that the Conservation Groups joined in the *Stipulation*.

**Therefore, It Is Ordered:**

1. The Mandatory Settlement Conference set for June 14, 1995 is **vacated**; and
2. Subcase No. 36-02080 is **set** for a **Status Conference** on June 14, 1995, at 3:00 p.m., in the SRBA Building, 253 Third Avenue North, Twin Falls, Idaho. Those parties wishing to participate by telephone may do so if they contact the clerk prior to June 7, 1995.


