The Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) forwarded your application for permit 63-34958 to McConnel Island Ditch Company. This application proposes that the water will be pumped out of Ross Drain on to your property and then allowed to flow back into Ross Drain. McConnel Island Ditch Company has discussed this application with its Chairman and its attorney. McConnel Island has elected not to protest your application. However, McConnel Island is concerned that the future operations of your pumping and storage on your property might have an effect on adjacent property such as by flooding or by backing up water in the drain so that the drain does not operate as intended. Mr. Van Vliet has discussed these concerns with you and does not want to interfere with how you use your property. If any of the operations under this water right, either by pumping or impounding water from the Ross Drain, causes any adverse impacts, McConnel Island will bring these impacts to your attention. McConnel Island and Mr. Van Vliet are confident that that you will deal responsibly with those concerns if and when they occur.

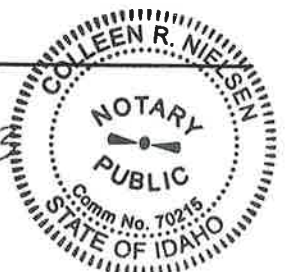
