



The Idaho Department of Water Resources (Department) is returning your Application to Sell or Lease a Water Right to the Water Supply Bank (Application Number 1725), which was received on May 14, 2020. Your application proposed to lease portions of water rights 35-13944, 35-13946 & 35-13948 into the Bank. This letter explains how a decision was made on your application.

Water Supply Bank rule 25.02 (IDAPA 37.02.03) describes the materials needed for a complete application. Upon initial review, the Department has determined your application is incomplete. You have not provided information that the water right has not been lost through abandonment or forfeiture, required by rule 25.02.c. The Department has requested the needed information as required in rule 25.04, however the requested information has not been supplied. Therefore, the Water Supply Bank is declining to lease into the Bank water rights 35-13944, 35-13946 & 35-13948.
