

EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. <u>It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:</u>

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. **Note:** the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

(a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or
 (b) The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.

APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

As a follow up to our telephone discussion on November 19, 2020 with Watermaster Nathan Erickson, enclosed is a schematic showing the proposed water systems that will be used for land application of industrial wastewater effluent from the proposed True West Beef facility near Jerome.

Two hydraulically separate systems, designated as irrigation and industrial, are proposed.

- The irrigation system will be sourced with groundwater diverted from irrigation wells as authorized by irrigation water rights nos. 36-2283, 36-2386, 36-2608, 36-14617, and 36-16951. The irrigation water will be supplemented with industrial wastewater effluent within a portion of the authorized place of use. This system will irrigate a maximum of 688.6 acres. The irrigated area will be accurately depicted with a "206 map" that will be updated if changes are made to the irrigation system.
- The industrial system will be supplied with industrial wastewater effluent and dilution water diverted from industrial wells as authorized by industrial water rights nos. 36-17172 and 36-17173. The land application area supplied from the industrial system can be identified on a map if requested.



Evaluation of Sufficiency Memorandum

Application proposes changing the points of diversion, place of use, nature of use and period of use for a 264.6 acre portion (3.5 cfs) of two combined irrigation ground water rights that are both currently diverted from the same well. Current place of use and point of diversion are located approximately 4.0 to 4.8 miles east and 1.0 to 1.6 miles north of the city center of Jerome The proposed change of nature of use will be from irrigation to industrial use for a new beef processing facility to be located at the current irrigation place of use. The application proposes diverting from two proposed wells to be drilled adjacent to the facility. Application also proposes reuse of the industrial water by land applying in a permissible place of use (PPU) proposed in companion transfer #84385. Proposed PPU will be located approximately 4.0 to 6.8 miles east and 0.9 to 2.2 miles north of the city center of Jerome.

The change in nature of use analysis from irrigation to industrial use examined acre to volume conversion utilizing the precipitation deficit (Pdef) values for crops grown on the farm's 347.06 acre tract (alfalfa, spring grain and sugar beets) utilizing data from the Jerome weather station as calculated on the University of Idaho's ETIdaho website. FSA crop records were also provided. The provided analysis indicated the initial calculated Pdef (2.72 af/ac) and the diversion volume reported in IDWR's WMIS database (3.12 af/ac) resulted in an unlikely irrigation efficiency of 87%. The irrigation efficiency was then assumed to be at 80% and analysis estimated an acceptable consumptive use of 2.50 af/ac to be used as the conversion rate. For additional information see Attachment 8A in the transfer application.

The farm is located within the ESPA model boundary, but modeling was not required as the wells are all located in the same or adjacent cells. All wells and POUs in the transfer are located within water District 130. Watermaster comments were solicited and the Watermaster did not oppose approval of the application provided the transfer is conditioned to limit the application of industrial water to land covered by active irrigation rights.

 Authority to File: Applicant is listed as the current owner of all water rights and properties associated with this transfer application. • Water Right Validity: Water right 36-2283 was decreed in the SRBA on 8/27/2001 and water right 36-14617 was decreed in the SRBA on 1/2/2002. Recent aerial imagery indicates the associated grounds appear to be irrigated.

Injury to Other Water Rights:

None anticipated.

Enlargement of Use:

There is a decrease in volume as a result of the change in nature of use process which precludes potential enlargement of the changed portion of the water right.

Local Public Interest:

No issues anticipated.

• Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources:

Proposed use is recognized as a beneficial use of water.

• Effect on the Economy of the Local Area:

This facility will create new jobs in the local area and provide local cattle ranchers a convenient option for processing their product.
