Condition no. 4 of this permit states:

"A fish screen of ¼ inch or smaller mesh shall be installed and maintained at the point of diversion.

You must comply with conditions of the permit without delay and prior to the field examination. I have enclosed a copy of this permit for your information. If you feel the condition is unnecessary you may submit a written request to the Department asking the requirement be waived.

The next step in the process of developing a water right is for the Department to conduct a field examination to determine and confirm the use being made of the water.

In-house field examination

At the time proof of beneficial use was filed, we tried to perform and in-house exam, but were unable to clearly see a spring or any water troughs with the imagery that was available. Therefore, it is recommended that a field exam or drive by exam be made to GPS the spring and water troughs. The house is visible in the aerial imagery, so that shouldn't be an issue. The spring could actually be an arm of the creek or in stream bed, so it would pay to confirm its location.
