6. Basis of Protest:

By Changing the point of diversion on these water rights, it will alter the way the water has been historically administered based on priority dates. All of the junior water right holders on Lee Creek will be adversely affected.

7. What would resolve your protest?

Delivering the water according to the 1930s agreement between the former owners of the McConnell Ranch and the other water users on Lee Creek via higher ditch. Along with having a proper headgate and a measuring device.

OR

McConnell's can make no claim to any water from the east fork of Lee Creek(Everson and Stroud)

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A protestant is required to timely file a protest with the department together with a \$25.00 protest fee for each application being protested in order for the protestant to be considered a full party by the department. In addition, the department's Rule of Procedure, IDAPA 37.01.01203, requires a protestant to send a copy of a protest to the applicant.
