The Department of Water Resources is reviewing the permit referenced above prior to issuing water right licenses. By issuing licenses, the Department confirms that water rights have been established in compliance with the terms of the permits. The examiner who verified your water use reported that the point of diversion developed is in a location other than what was described on your permit. Therefore, before licenses can be issued, your permits must be amended to depict your water rights as they were actually developed.

The enclosed Application for Amendment forms depict the point of diversion and place of use and other information as they will appear on the licenses when they are issued. Please review the amendment forms carefully. If you concur with the information presented, please sign the forms and return them with the \$100.00 filing fee within 14 days.

The Idaho Department of Water Resources hereby approves the above Application for Amendment for Permit No. 63-34022 with the following:									
Conditions	of Approval								
 The irrigation occurring under this domestic use shall not exceed 1/2 acre. Domestic use is for 1 home. The domestic use authorized under this right shall not exceed 13,000 gallons per day per home. When ordered by the Director, the right holder shall provide mitigation acceptable to the Director to offset depletion of lower Snake River flows needed for migrating anadromous fish. The amount of water required for mitigation, which is to be released into the Snake River or a tributary for this purpose, will be determined by the Director based upon the reduction in flow caused by the use of water pursuant to this right. Any order of the Director issued in accordance with this paragraph shall be in conformance with applicable rules allowing the right holder due process as the need for mitigation and the amount of mitigation are determined.
