**AMENDED CLAIM TO A WATER RIGHT**

Under the provisions of Section 42-243, *Idaho Code*, any person claiming a water right established by diversion and application of water to beneficial use must file a claim with the Department of Water Resources. **The filing of this claim does not confirm the water right claimed.** Water rights represented by a valid permit, license, decree, or previous claim are exempt from this requirement, as are uses of water for domestic purposes as defined in Section 42-111, *Idaho Code*. A filing fee must be submitted with this claim. See the instruction sheet to determine the appropriate fee.

WE NORMALLY DIVERT 2-3 FT INCHES OF WATER FROM EACH DAM. FLOWING WELLS ARE USED TO SUPPLEMENT THE CREEK WATER. HOWEVER, DUE TO THE LIMITED VOLUME, THEY DO NOT COVER MUCH ACREAGE.

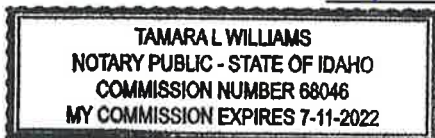

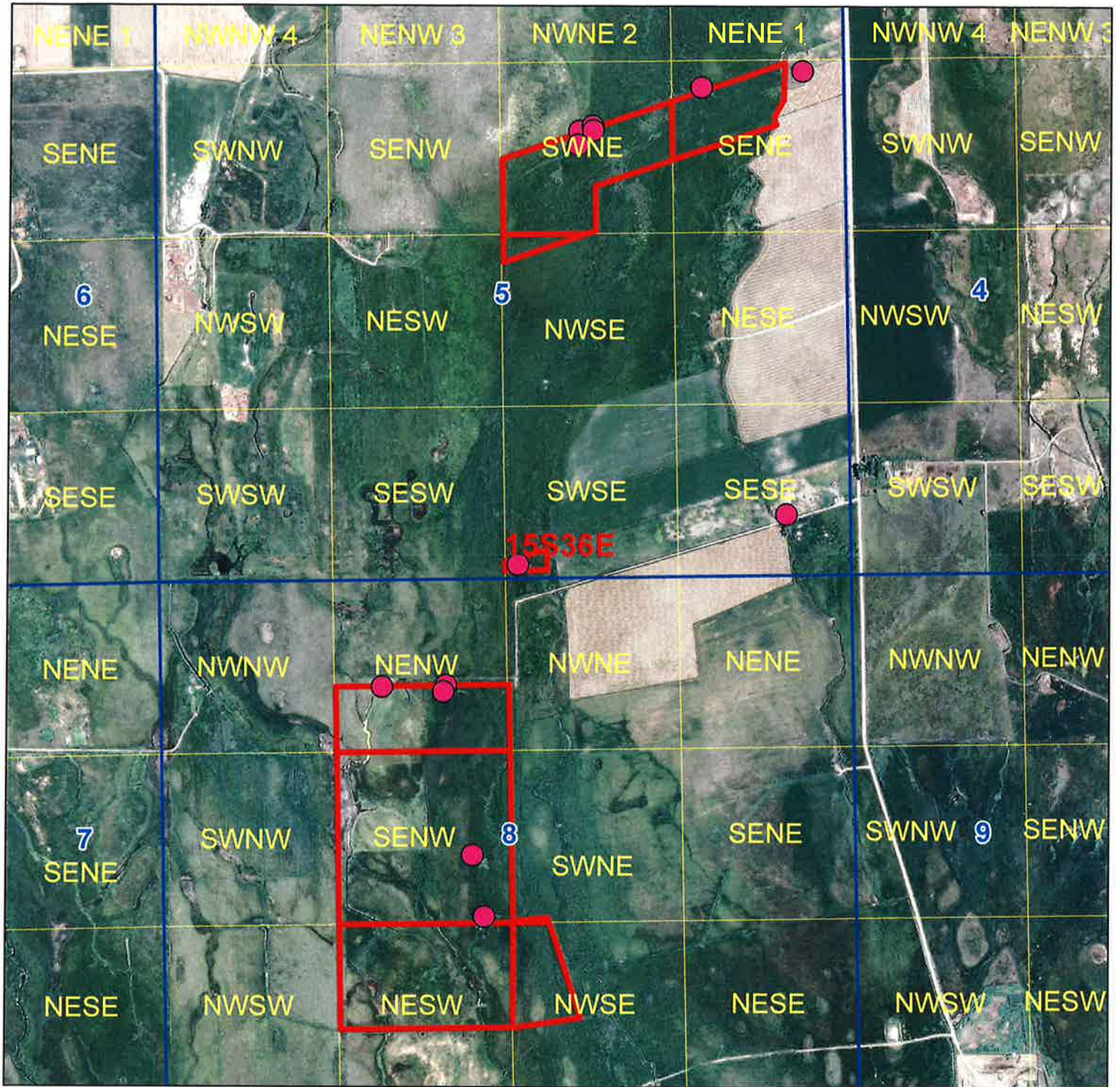
