Appendix B: Eckhardt Family LLLP Rights Subject to Injury

### 1. OVERVIEW

Double C & J Land Co ("Applicant") filed Application for Permit No. 67-15333 seeking to divert 345 afy from Jenkins Creek for Irrigation Storage, Irrigation from Storage, Stockwater Storage, and Stockwater from Storage. The Applicant describes the storage facility as an existing dam that has historically impounded water from Jenkins Creek and Monroe Creek.

Eckhardt Family LLLP (Eckhardt) filed a Notice of Protest against Application for Permit No. 67-15333 on the basis that diversions from Jenkins Creek have the potential to injure the ability of Eckhardt to put their downstream senior water right to use and that no authorization to use the Monroe Reservoir exists.

This report evaluates the Application's compliance with the requirements for approval set forth in Idaho Code § 42-203A(5). When reviewing Applications for Permit, the Director of the Department of Water Resources (IDWR) considers a number of criteria, including:

- (a) whether the Application will reduce the quantity of water under existing water rights, or
- (b) whether the water supply itself is insufficient for the purpose for which it is sought to be appropriated, or
- (c) whether it appears to the satisfaction of the director that such application is not made in good faith, is made for delay or speculative purposes, or
- (d) whether the applicant has not sufficient financial resources with which to complete the work involved therein, or
- (e) whether it will conflict with the local public interest as defined in section 42-202B, Idaho Code, or
- (f) whether it is contrary to conservation of water resources within the state of Idaho, or
- (g) whether it will adversely affect the local economy of the watershed or local area within which the source of water for the proposed use originates, in the case where the place of use is outside of the watershed or local area where the source of water originates.

As discussed below, the Application has the potential to reduce the quantity of water under existing water rights. Eckhardt has also raised concerns regarding speculation as Double C & J does not have authorization from Eckhardt (or BLM or Maddox) to store Jenkins Creek water at Monroe Reservoir.

# 2. Application for Permit 67-15333

### 2.1. Description of Application

Application for Permit 67-15333 ("Application") was filed by Double C & J Land Co and received by IDWR on October 1, 2019. The original filing was incomplete and a complete application was filed on October 23, 2019. The application proposes a point of diversion at 12N 5W Section 6 NESW. The application proposes diverting a total of 345 afy with the following amounts, uses and season:

345 afy for Irrigation Storage from 1/1 to 12/31

345 afy for Irrigation from Storage from 3/1/to 11/15

345 afy for Stockwater Storage from 1/1 to 12/31

345 afy for Stockwater from Storage from 1/1 to 12/31

The diverting works are described as "Existing dam on Jenkins Creek that has historically impounded water from Jenkins Creek and Monroe Creek." The reservoir is stated to have an active reservoir capacity of 345 af. Stock watering is described as 250 (the kind of livestock is not described). The application describes a place of use of 453 acres for irrigation from storage use with stockwater from storage use in the same location. The 453-acre place of use appears to correspond with other water rights owned by the Applicant for irrigation use including 67-2044, 67-2097A, 67-2097B, 67-4520, 67-14246, 67-14247, and 67-14251.

The application states that the point of diversion for the right is owned by the BLM and Eckhardt Family LLLP. Similarly, the storage facility known as Monroe Reservoir is not owned by the Applicant. The application's narrative states:

"This application is filed in order to legally allow diversion of water from Jenkins Creek into Monroe Reservoir. Diversion of Jenkins Creek water into Monroe Reservoir has taken place for over 100 years, with the point of diversion claimed in the SRBA. On file with IDWR is a transfer to legally recognize the past 100 years of historic practice. No time is needed to complete the works as they are existing."

# 2.2. Other Right Associated with Application's Storage Facility

Application for Permit 67-15333 proposes diverting water from Jenkins Creek into storage on a year-round basis. The facility proposed to store water is located on Jenkins Creek is an existing dam and reservoir that is locally known as Monroe Reservoir. Decreed water right 67-2044, owned by Double C & J Land Co, authorizes the following uses:

6.4 cfs for Diversion to Storage from 11/15 to 03/15

320 afy for Irrigation Storage from 1/1 to 12/31

#### 320 afy Irrigation from Storage from 3/15 to 11/15

The irrigation place of use for this right is the same 453 acres described by Application 67-15333. The point of diversion from Monroe Creek is located at 13N 06W Section 25 SENENE. Water right 67-2044 does not identify the location of the storage facility. No water rights owned by either the applicant or anyone else identifies the storage facility in NESW Section 6, T12N, R5W or diverting Jenkins Creek water into storage at that location.

The adjudication claim file for 67-2044 describes that water is diverted from Monroe Creek and conveyed through a ditch to Monroe Reservoir. Notes in the adjudication file indicate that the ditch from Monroe Creek to Jenkins Creek was not functional at the time of the adjudication. The claim, and subsequent decree, do not list Jenkins Creek as a source for storage.

# 3. ECKHARDT FAMILY LLLP RIGHTS

Eckhardt owns the following right associated with Jenkins Creek that stand to be injured by Double C & J's Application for Permit 67-15333.




Figure 1: Point of diversion and places of use for Double C & J application for permit 67-15333, and downstream points and place of use for Eckhardt right 67-11045.

Decreed water right 67-11045 with a June 27, 1934 priority date authorizes year-round diversion of 0.02 cfs from Jenkins Creek for instream stockwater use. The beginning and ending points of stream flow is 12N 5W Section 30 NENWNW (Lt 1). This right is located on Jenkins Creek downstream of the storage facility listed by the Application. The place of use for this right is depicted in Figure 1.

# 4. REDUCED FLOW (INJURY) ANALYSIS

The Application proposes diversion of water from Jenkins Creek into storage on a year-round basis. Storage releases will be used by the Applicant for irrigation and stockwater. The Application provides no provisions for releasing water to meet Eckhart's water right 67-11045, an in-stream stockwater right located downstream of the storage facility with a senior priority date to Application 67-15333. Eckhart water rights may be injured due to the reduced ability to use Jenkins Creek water unless sufficient flow is allowed to pass the dam to fulfill 67-11045.

# 5. GOOD FAITH / SPECULATION




Figure 2: Parcel Map Surrounding the Monroe Reservoir

Figure 2 shows a snippet of the Washington County Parcel Map, in which the three parcels forming a mosaic over the storage facility in the center of Section 6 T12N, R5W include:

- RP12N05W062400 owned by Eckhardt Family, LLLP
- RP12N05W064200 owned by BLM
- RP12N05W060000 owned by Maddox Bar EX Ranch LTD PRTSHP

The Application identified the POD at the Monroe Reservoir, which is on land owned by others. One of the IDWR's criteria for approval will be a consideration whether the application is speculative. In this instance, the Application is made with the POD located on property the applicant does not own and no evidence that there is an agreement or authorization to store Jenkins Creek water with Eckhardt, BLM or Maddox.

# 6. SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

Eckhardt protests Application for Permit 67-15333 on concerns that diversions from Jenkins Creek has the potential to affect the ability to fulfill their senior downstream water right and that the Applicant is storing water in a facility located on land owned by Eckhardt, BLM, and Maddox without authorization.
