



In response to your letter dated September 3, 2020, regarding the Application to Lease Water Right 47-7689 to the Water Supply Bank by Miracle Mile, LLC, and your request for additional information, the responses are as follows:

Application to Lease Water Right 47-7689 / Water Supply Bank

- 1. Affirmation that the pond areas will not continue to receive any water, and that they will be dried up, or, if the ponds will continue to receive water, information as to how a reduction in recreation beneficial use will be measured such that enlargement or overuse of water does not occur:
 - Water Right 47-7689 includes the following amounts: 1) Heating (0.193 cfs) and 2) Recreation (0.094 cfs), for a total of 0.287 cfs.
 - Only a portion of these water rights are offered to the Bank. A summary of the amount of water rights available, compared to the amount of water rights offered to the Bank, is as follows:
 - Heating:
 - Water right amount: 0.193 cfs
 - Less amount offered to the Bank: 0.037 cfs
 - Amount reserved by Applicant: 0.156 cfs
 - Recreation:
 - Water right amount: 0.094 cfs
 - Less Amount offered to the Bank: 0.094 cfs
 - Amount reserved by Applicant: 0.000 cfs
 - o In total, 0.156 cfs will remain with the Applicant and will not be offered to the Bank. As such, the ponds will continue to receive water.
 - o Measurement of reduction in recreation beneficial use:
 - The reduction in recreation beneficial use will be measured using the flow measurement device currently in operation at the well. This will ensure that only 0.156 cfs is used by the Applicant, avoiding any enlargement or overuse of water.

- 2. <u>Information pertaining to the use of the water right for hydropower generation</u>
 - Specifically how power will continue to be generated while the water right is being idled
 - o The only power generated in connection with this water right is by photo-voltec panels.
 - Water Right 47-7689 does not permit the use of hydropower generation.
 - o Installation of the micro-hydro system was done together with the installation of the photo-voltec panels because it was more economical to install the two systems simultaneously.
 - There is no intent to use the micro-hydro system at this time. If this ever changes, an application for a water right permitting hydropower use would first be submitted.
- 3. Confirmation of the identity of an individual who is an authorized agent for Miracle Mile LLC
 - o I, James Reed, am an authorized agent for Miracle Mile, LLC.
 - o Attached is the Reinstatement Annual Report for Miracle Mile, LLC filed with the Idaho Secretary of State on October 1, 2020, which lists me as a member of the LLC.

The Department of Water Resources (Department) has conducted a preliminary review of your application to lease water right 47-7689 to the Water Supply Bank and determined that your application is incomplete. The following items are required to continue processing your application:
