#### Conditions of Approval:

- 1. The right holder shall maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works from the West fork of Threemile Creek.
- 2. The two (2) ponds established by the storage of water under this right shall not exceed a total capacity of 2.3 acre-feet or a total surface area of 0.8 acre.
- Right 37-23250 authorizes the storage of an annual total of 3.9 acre-feet, comprised of 2.3 acre-feet to be used for the initial filling or carryover storage of the ponds and 1.3 acre-feet for the replacement of losses due to evaporation. An additional 416 acre feet of flow through water is authorized by the wildlife and aesthetic uses under right 37-8859.
- 4. R05 Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 37.
- To mitigate for the depletion of water resulting from the diversion and use of water under this right and to prevent injury to other water right holders, the right holder shall cease diverting and using 0.04 cfs for the irrigation of 1.7 acres within the NENW of Section 23, T01N, R13E. Moreover, the official record for right 37-368A has been changed to show that 0.04 cfs on 1.7 acres is dedicated to mitigation, and the permissible place of use for irrigation use for rights 37-368A, 37-409A, 37-2076A, 37-2455 and 37-2157 has been removed from these same 1.7 acres, which reduces the permissible place of use from 515.6 acres to 513.9 acres.
- 6. F06 The following rights are diverted through point(s) of diversion described above: 37-368B, 37-2076A, 37-2076B, and 37-8859.




