





## EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:

### <u>PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION</u>

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. Note: the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

#### **EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS**

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

#### REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

## **ORAL ARGUMENT**

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

## **CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE**

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

## **FINAL ORDER**

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

- (a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or
- (b) The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.

## APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, if this preliminary order becomes final, any party aggrieved by the final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal the final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

The appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of this preliminary order becoming final. See section 67-5273, Idaho Code. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.

**Evaluation of Application** 

Transfer 84109 proposes changing the place of use of water rights 63-34303 through 63-34312 and 63-34399 to a common 342-acre place of use (POU) within a 542-acre permissible place of use (ppu). The transfer also proposes adding adding points of diversion (PODs) to the ground water rights involved in the transfer so all the groundwater rights share four (4) common PODs.

The site is located in Kuna just east of Cloverdale Rd. and west of S. Cole Rd, less than a mile south of Kuna Mora Rd.

### **Deviations from Transfer Policy Standards**

One POD of water right 63-34339 is updated from NWSESE to SESE to match Department's data entry standard for ground water POD legal description. All diversion rates, volumes, and acre descriptions are rounded to three significant-figues per department standards.

#### **Summary of Information Submitted**

#### **Authority to File:**

Transfer 84109 was submitted in the name of CS Properties Development LLC and signed by Thomas J Basabe. CS Property was made the current owner of the water rights involved in transfer 84109 following an ownership change processed in 2019. Thomas J Basabe is a registered director of J.R. Simpolot Co. Secretary of State Records list Simplot as as a managing entity of CS Property Development LLC giving Thomas J Basabe signing authority. CS Property also owns the land appurtenant to the proposed water right place of use (POU) and PODs.

#### Water Right Validity:

All twelve water rights involved in this transfer resulted from a series of splits originating from water rights decreed in 2007. All rights are presumed valid because beneficial use has occurred within the last five years. Benefical use is confirmed by department aerial imagery. Transfers involving all or some of the rights within transfer 84109 and/or their related parent rights occurred in 2014 and 2017. Beneficial use was analyzed during both of these past transfers, further confirming the validity of the rights in the transfer.

#### Injury to Other Water Rights:

Transfer 84109 is not expected to injure local water rights. The transfer proposes new groundwater PODs within the South Ada County Ground Water area of concern so potential injury to local wells and ground water availability must be considered. The new proposed PODs are on existing wells within CS Property's irrigation system. CS Properties proposes no changes to the surface water PODs.

#### **Enlargement of Use & Water Right Overlap:**

#### Overlap Analysis:

The POU of water rights 63-34303 through 63-34312 currently overlap, sharing a common ppu. Water right 63-34339 does not overlap the other 10 rights involved this transfer nor any other right not involved in this transfer. Ground water rights 63-34304 through 63-34311 were conditioned to supplement surface water rights 63-34303 and 63-34312 during transfer application 79452 processed and approved in 2014. These conditions were likely added by default because surface rights were involved in the transfer. The Department will maintin these conditions from the 2014 transfer, but will view the ground water rights as largely primary since the surface water provides relatively little water and irrigated acres compared to the groundwater rights in this transfer. Furthermore, the supplemental groundwater condition will not be added to water right 63-34339.

#### Combined Use Limit Analysis:

Water rights 63-34303 – 63-34312 contain three separate but partly related combined use limit conditions. The first ("Condition 1") limits water rights 63-34307, 63-34309, 63-34310 and 63-34312 to 1.19 cfs, 267 AF, and 59.3 irrigated acres. The second ("Condition 2") limits water rights 63-34305, 63-34306, 63-34308 and 63-34311 to 578 AF, and 129 irrigated acres. The third ("Condition 3") limits water rights 63-34303 – 63-34312 to 3.54 cfs, 937 AF, and 211 irrigated acres. Condition 3 is most limiting of AF and irrigated acres. However, the 1.19 cfs diversion rate limit of Condition 1, added to the decreed diversion rates of 63-34303, 63-34304, 63-34305, 63-34306, 63-34308, and 63-34311 equals 3.48 cfs which is less than the 3.54 cfs limited by Condition 3. Therefore, the Department will update Condition 3 from 3.54 cfs to 3.48 cfs. The Department will also add a new combined use condition limiting all 11 rights within the transfer to 5.81 cfs, 1570 AF, and 3.42 acres. (See overlap and combined use analysis tables attached.)

#### Enlargement:

So long as the applicant adheres to the combined use conditions added through this transfer and the previously added conditions on each water right, enlargement will not occur.

#### **Local Public Interest:**

When transfer 84109 was advertised, the Department notified Water District 63's water master. The water master expressed no concerns about the approval of this transfer. No evidence suggests the transfer coflicts with other areas of local public interst.

#### Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources:

The application proposes beneficial use consistent with conservation of water resources in Idaho.

The application is consistent with criteria of I. C. § 42-222 and should be processed.

#### **Discussion**

The 6/22/1990 priority date for water right 63-34304 is updated to 6/21/2020 to reflect the priority date listed on the license issued to parent right 63-11343 in 1993.

#### **POU Boundary Within PPU:**

The transfer allows 342 acres within a 542 ppu. Since the ppu is significantly greater than the irrigated acres, the applicant submitted a POU boundary outlining the 342 acres they intend to irrigate with the ppu. CS Property may shift the 342 irrigated acres within their ppu without transfer by submitting an updated POU map piror to any irrigation season.

#### **Condition Error Corrections:**

Condition X27 (now 206) on water right 63-34309 incorrectly limited irrigation to 61.5 acres. This error resulted from an oversight during the split ownership change processed in 2016- the parent right of 63-34309 had an 61.5 irrigation acre limit before split. Right 63-34309 should have been reduced from 61.5 to 38.0 after the 2016 split but was not. The condition is updated at this time to reflect the true acre limit of 38.0 acres.

The condition on water right 63-34309 limiting the combined use of water rights 63-34303 – 63-34312 contained a typo. The maximum diversion rate was incorrectly conditioned as 3.04 cfs. It should have been conditioned as 3.54 cfs based on this condition on all other rights in this group. This condition is now updated to 3.48 cfs as described under the "Enlargement of Use & Water Right Overlap – Enlargement" section of this memo.

The extended irrigation condition X61 on water right 63-34312 is removied at this time because it was redundant. The extened irrigation season condition on water right 63-34312 allowed irrigation beginning 3/1 which is the beginning irrigation date decreed on this right.

Water rights 63-34304, 63-34306, 63-34307, 63-34309, and 63-34310 are also conditioned with X61 extending the early irrigation season to 3/1. Condition X61 will be maintained on these five rights as they are each decreed with an irrigation season beginning 3/15. The 4/10/2007 date listed at the end of condition X61 on water right 63-34304 is corrected to 9/22/2014- the approval date of transfer 79452, through which condition X61 was first added to 63-34304. The 2/6/2007 date at the end of condition X61 on the other four rights is corrected to reflect the true decree date of 2/16/2007.




