Project construction shall commence within one year from the date of permit issuance and shall proceed diligently to completion unless it can be shown to the satisfaction of the Director of the Department of Water Resources that delays were due to circumstances over which permit holder had no control.
- 4. Use of water under this right is subject to control by the watermaster of State Water District No. 72F.
- 5. A lockable device, subject to the approval of the Department, shall be installed on the diverting works in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversion prior to diversion of water under this right.
- 6. Place of use is located within HES 613 & HES 501.
- 7. Domestic use is for 1 home.
- The domestic use authorized under this right shall not exceed 13,000 gallons per day per dwelling in accordance with Section 42-111, Idaho Code.
- 9. Prior to diversion of water under this permit, the permit holder must obtain approval from all the required state and federal agencies.



SUBJECT: Review and Recommendation

This application proposes to divert a small amount of water for irrigation of a small tract of land and the use is such that it can be considered "domestic" pursuant to 42-111. The application mentions the use will be around a cabin site and the map shows that the cabin will also be served by a well.

The source is Morgan Creek which has a decree on it and at times prior decreed rights require the full flow in the creek. Morgan Creek is organized under WD 72F however the district is not active and no watermaster has been appointed for years.

Recommendation:

I recommend that the application be approved with the following conditions:

- 1. Subject to prior water rights and subject to control by elected watermaster for Morgan Creek.
- 2. A measuring device and means of control be provided at point of diversion for regulation by watermaster.
- 3. When this right and the domestic right which may be established by using the well at the cabin site are combined the total use shall not exceed 13,000 gallons per day nor irrigation of more than 1/2 acre of land.
- 4. Permit is subject other county, state & federal approvals that may be required.


