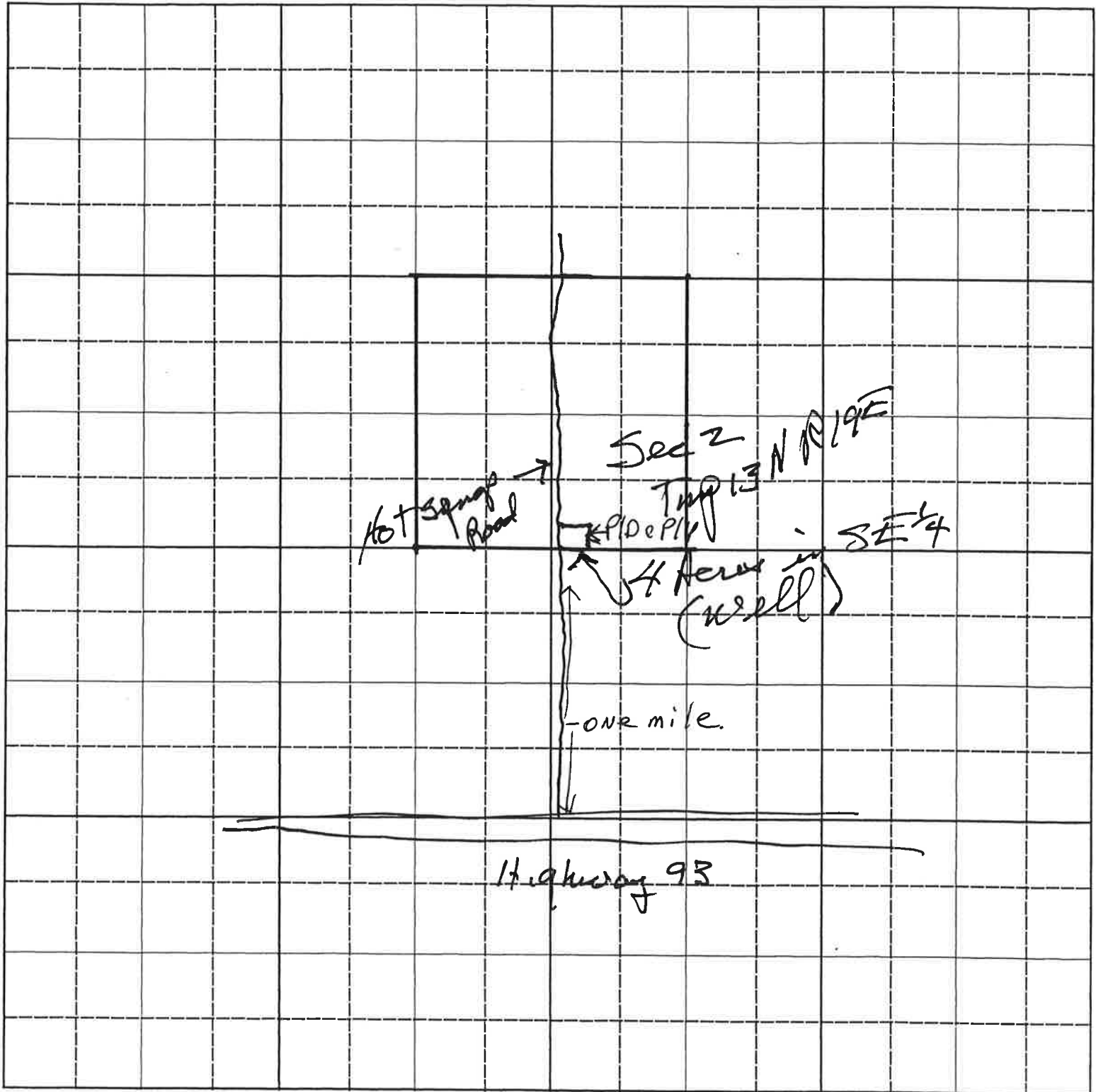

Gave me the legal of 13N, 19E, Section 28 and the name of Robert Webster and said he had a pump in the Salmon River and a domestic well and she wanted to know if it had any water rights? I found this water right number but there has been no AJ claim filed and there was nothing on the domestic well. Sent her a claim form and profile report for this right.

Gave me the legal of 13N, 19E, SWSE of Section 2 and the name of George Forestier. The only thing I found was this Lapsed Permit. Forestier apparently sold to John Brock (there was evidence in the water right file that they attempted to change the ownership back in Nov. of 1993 but had the wrong forms and then never followed up on it) and Mr. Brock has recently passed away. Told her they could either submit evidence that the system was in place prior to the expiration of the permit on June 17, 1994 and request reinstatement of the permit, or just apply for a new permit and start the process again... She said Mr. Forestier put a bigger pump in and strung out a few lines but really didn't develop the system because he sold it to Brock. She had me send her a new Application for Permit and the new owners will start the process again...

A profile report, blank claim form, and a Request for Extension of Time to File Adjudication Claim. The latest direction we have is that the request must be filed before the claim is accepted and a determination is made on late fee charges. 
