





Dear Mr. Roskelly:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) wishes to resolve our protest to your application for permit No. 72-07478 for domestic and stockwater use. At our meeting on site on March 25, 1992, a number of issues were discussed and verbally agreed upon. Implementation of these verbal agreements will result in resolution of the BLM's protest. I would like to review and document those verbal agreements.

Mr. Roskelly, you have agreed to modify the requested amount of diversion to more accurately reflect actual and expected use. The domestic use claim will be modified to .04 cfs (cubic feet per second) which is approximately eighteen (18) gallons per minute. The livestock use claim will be .02 cfs, which is approximately nine (9) gallons per minute and 13,000 gallons per day.

The BLM will process the right-of-way application you are required to file prior to development of the spring. Prior to issuance of the BLM right-of-way appropriate environmental review, cultural clearances and rare species clearances will be conducted. The right-of-way may be approved, refused, or granted with conditions by the BLM. In exchange for an acceptable spring development right-of-way, you will grant a permanent administrative access right-of-way to the BLM lands adjacent to and accessible through your private property.

A connection will be provided on your diversion facilities above the cistern such that the BLM may, at some future date, access the diverted water for development of a water source for wildlife. BLM withdrawals from your diversion facilities will not exceed .02 cfs. Your diversion capacity will be developed to accommodate your requested diversion amounts and the .02 cfs of the BLM up to the point of BLM withdrawal from your diversion.

Water production at the spring in excess of your domestic and livestock claim will be left at the source for continued maintenance of existing vegetation. Collection facilities for your diversion will be constructed only in the existing trench and access, and natural channel below this trench will not be disturbed. Diverted water in excess of your domestic and livestock needs will be allowed to return to BLM land for support of vegetation and wildlife.

These conditions and agreements reflect our understanding of an acceptable resolution to the BLM protest of your water permit claim. A copy of this letter is being provided to Harold Jones at the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR). Please provide the BLM and IDWR with your written acceptance and concurrence with the agreements identified herein.

If you have any questions or require further clarification, please contact David Blackstun or myself at 756-5400. I have no doubt that we can effectively work together to accommodate both our interests.
