

Dear Mr. and Ms. Wiens;

On December 4, 2019, the Idaho Department of Water Resources (Department) issued permit 63-34804 authorizing the development of a right to divert 0.04 cfs for domestic use and 0.03 cfs for irrigation use from ground water in the NW1/4 SW1/4 of Section 13, Township 3 North, Range 4 West.

On October 5, 2020, the Department received a Statement of Completion form from you stating that you had completed the work proposed on your permit. The final step in the water appropriation process is the issuance of a Water Right License. By issuing a license, the Department recognizes that water has been put to beneficial use in accordance with the permit. For your convenience, I have attached a copy of permit listed above.

This permit qualifies for what is known as in-house exam or desk top review instead of an in-field verification inspection of the property. A verification review is necessary to move this permit forward to a water right license. During my review of your file, I was able to verify most of the elements needed to license your permit. However, there are a couple of issues that I need to confirm with you prior to preparing this permit to be licensed. I have listed each issue below:

1.) Our records show that you are within the borders of the Wilder Irrigation District. I need to confirm if you have access to the Wilder Irrigation District

water, and if you own the shares or if you pay for the right to use water from Wilder Irrigation District. Please let me know whether or not you can or may use Wilder Irrigation District water now or in the future. We do not have access to Wilder Irrigation District water.

- 2.) I found that an irrigation water right permit (63-34184) for Shiraz Pointe Home Owner's Association also included your property in the place of use for this permit. Do you have access to or use the water supplied by Shiraz Pointe Home Owner's Association for your property. I need to know if you use Shiraz Point Home Owner's Association water whether or not you supplement your well use with the Shiraz Pointe Home Owner's Association water or if your well supplements their water system. We do not have access to Shiraz Point HOA water.
- 3.) I also noticed that the Shiraz Pointe Home Owners Association's irrigation water right permit may be used to irrigate a strip of land on the west side of your property. I have inserted a map below that outlines the strip of ground I am speaking about in yellow. Do you use your well to irrigate the strip of land shown in the yellow border area, or is it irrigated with the Shiraz Pointe Home Owner's Association's irrigation system? The strip of grass on the west end of our property was set up by the developer to be irrigated by the community well before any home construction took place. It is still being irrigated by the HOA well.
