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

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL FOR TEMPORARY PERMIT NO. TP- 47-21

- Diversion must be screened to meet IDF&G requirements. We recommend contacting IDF&G for specifications.
- Pumping shall occur at a location away from potential fish refugia (streambanks with overhanging vegetation, large accumulations of woody debris, etc.) to avoid entraining juvenile fish.
- All equipment involved with transporting water shall be treated/sterilized to avoid spread of invasive aquatic species prior to use. If equipment involved with transporting water has been moved into Idaho from another state (Particularly from NV, CO, UT, AZ, CA or TX) contact ISDA for an inspection. We recommend contacting ISDA (208-332-8686) for treatment recommendations.
- Water shall not be transported or transferred between waterbodies.
- Subject to regulation by watermaster of Water District 47G.
