PART 1A.3:

This transfer proposes to unstack a 3.4 acre portion of Rapid Creek water right 29-294D from Jackson Creek water right 29-13385 and stack it with Portneuf River water rights 29-14262 and 29-2224K. The proposed point of diversion is located downstream from the confluence of Rapid Creek and the Portneuf. Rapid Creek water right 29-294D holds a 6/1/1885 priority date. Jackson Creek water right 29-13385 holds a 4/2/1947 priority date. Portneuf River water rights 29-2224K and 29-14262 hold a 10/4/1919 priority date. We seek to unstack the 3.4 acres of water right 29-294D from a water right 29-13385 (1947 priority) and stack it with water rights 29-2224K and 29-14262 which are more senior water rights. This will enable us to continue to irrigate the 3.4 acres described under 29-2224K and 29-14262 when the 10/4/1919 priority is cut. Jackson Creek water right 29-13385 is always cut before Portneuf River water rights 29-2224K and 29-14262. Rapid Creek water right 29-294D and Jackson Creek water right 29-13385 will not be used at the same time due to priority cuts on the Lower Portneuf drainage.

A purchase agreement is attached to this application. The agreement is to purchase 3.4 acres of Rapid Creek Water right 29-294D. The proposed place of use will cover land owned by holders of water rights 29-2224K and 29-14262. Letters from the water right owners have been supplied consenting to the filing of this transfer.

- a. The diversion point is adjacent to Rapid Creek and flows through a rudimentary headgate. To accommodate the measuring and locking controlling device order, a more sophisticated locking headgate is proposed to be implemented and following the headgate a type of EZ Flow Ramp Flume to measure the water before it continues to flow downward along the ditch.
- b. The point of diversion for water right 29-294D is owned by Stewart Nelson and is accessed by agreement through his field. The point of diversion for water rights 29-2224K and 29-14262 are owned by the applicant and his siblings.
- g. The ditch for the diversion point resides on Stewart Nelson's and Lindi Howell's property. For the past several years trees along Lindi Howell's property has been impeding flow of water. Last year the ditch was sprayed with roundup and was partially cleaned using a tractor, but the trees were impeding water flow. In September 2020 the water master has ok'd the proposal from Lindi Howell to place pipe into the ditch along her property to mitigate the water flow. This will be completed in the months of September and October 2020. Also additional pipe is proposed to be placed into the ditch to mitigate the flow of water from the diversion point to the point of uses within the year for water right holders to irrigate their respective parcels. Additionally, Kent Murdock has sold the property which this water right irrigates but has retained his own house and parcel as well as his son's that water right 29-294D irrigates. .07 CFS of the sold property is proposed to be transferred for beneficial use upon the circumstance of a water call. See attached quit claims for water right ownership of Kent Murdock.



















Contract Agreement to Transfer and purchase .07 CFS of Water Right 29-294D
