A spring arising in a small stream will be developed to increase the flow. The spring and stream flows will be captured in a small pond (30 ft diameter, avg 4 ft deep). If flows diminish and pond will not stay full, spring flows will be piped to a trough. Trough line will come off above pond so diversion from storage was not included. Total volume represents multiple fills of pond. Pond is so small that seepage and evaporative losses are insignificant.

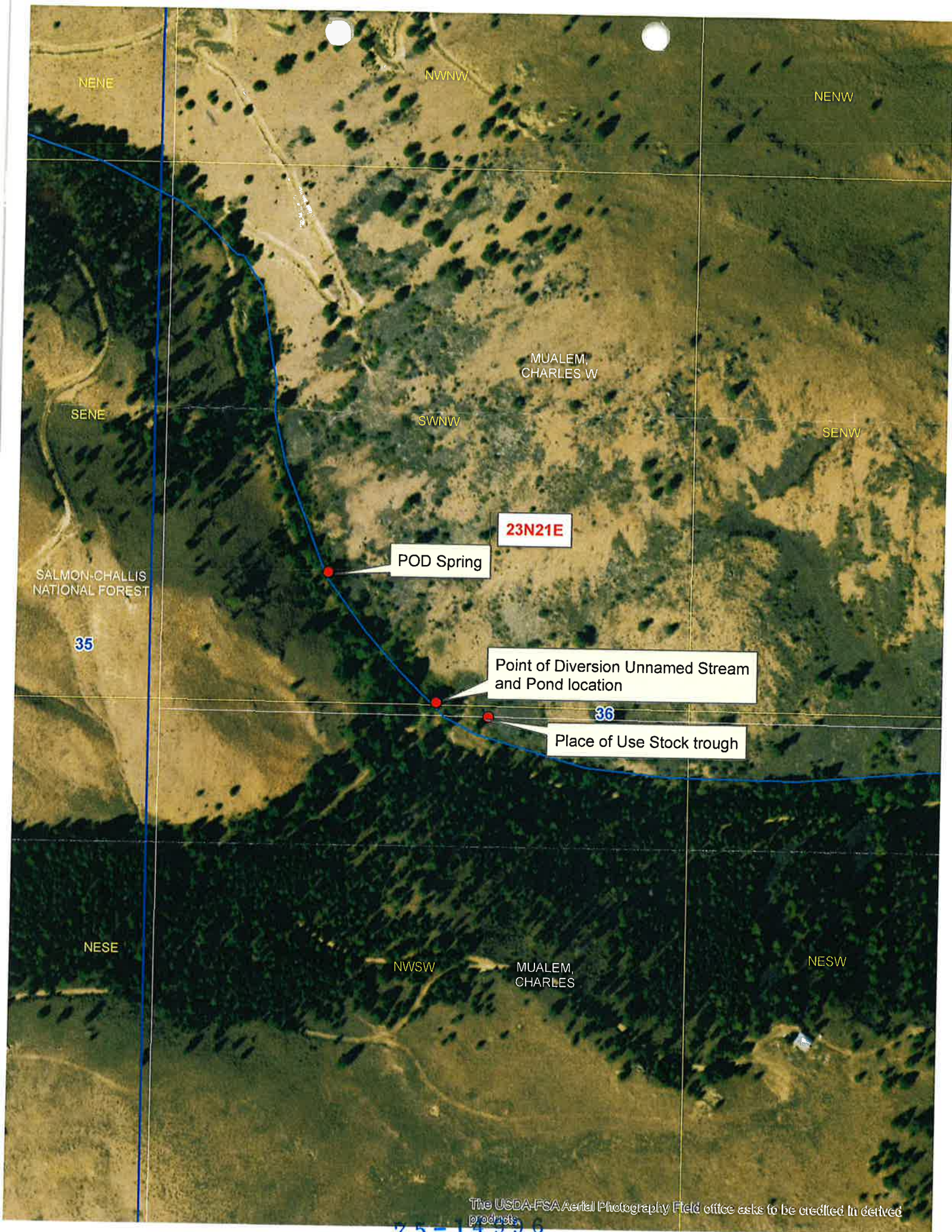

This application proposes the diversion and use of water from a spring and an unnamed stream, both tributary to the Salmon Wild & Scenic River. The decreed minimum stream flow rights for the federal Wild & Scenic Rivers are subordinate to certain categories of water use and to specific amounts of water use established after the minimum stream flow. The water use proposed in this application will benefit from the subordination provision because it is for stockwater purposes.
