Stanley Blair Sutton, age 85, of Archer, passed away at his home Wednesday, June 6, 2018.



Stan was born April 16, 1933 in Archer a son to Henry Lillis Sutton and Rachel Briggs Sutton. He went to Archer Grade School for eight years, graduated from Madison High School and attended Ricks College, where he played basketball. He was preceded in death by his parents, Henry Lillis and Rachel Sutton, a brother Jesse Sutton, 4 sisters; Zella Bybee, Laura Hope, Carol Robison and Ada Lou Howell and his son Bret Sutton.

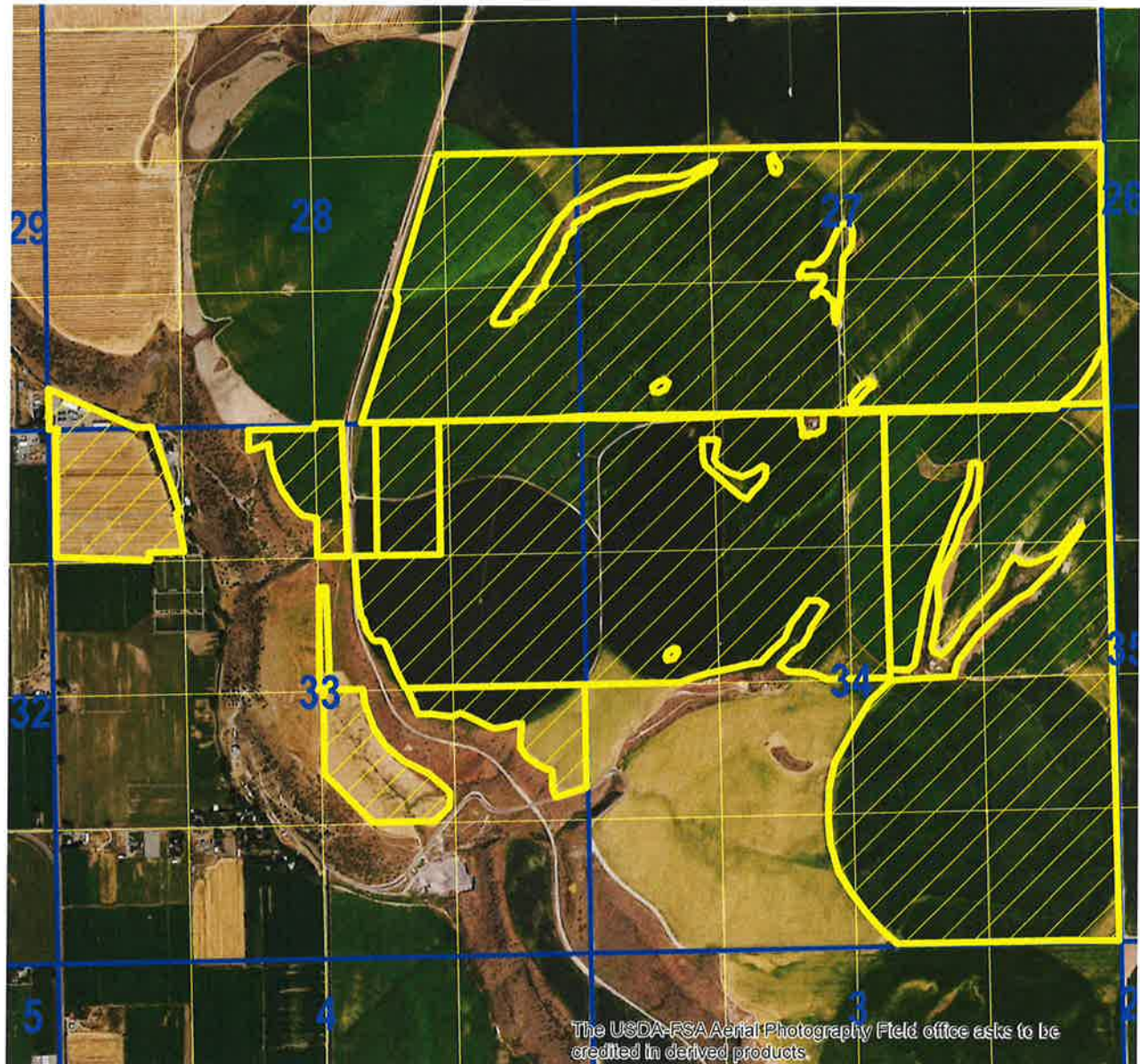

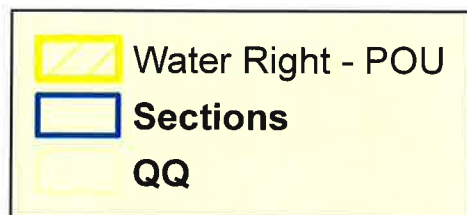

Existing Places of Use



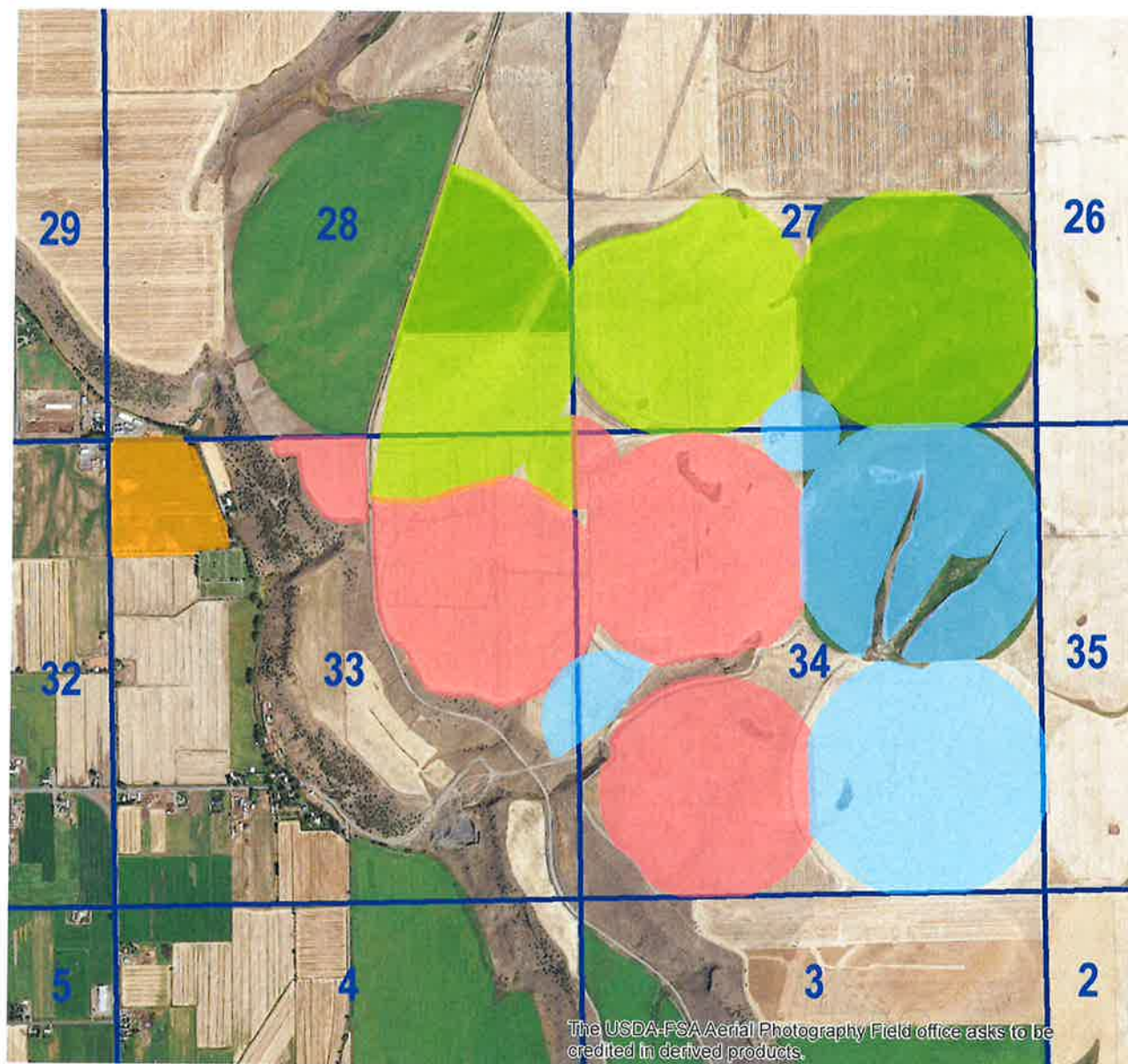

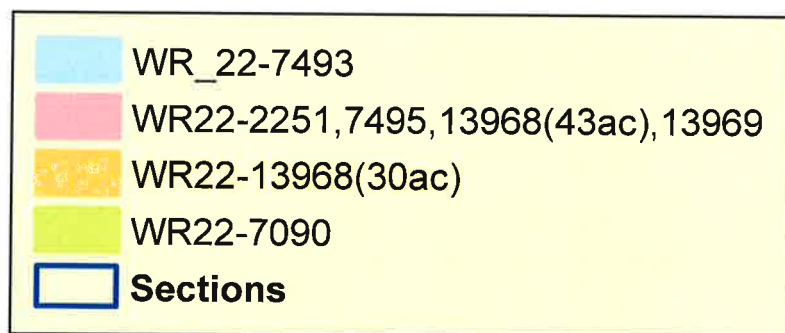


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Proposed Places of Use
