Dear Applicant:

This office received your application on August 10, 2020. The application cannot be accepted into the records of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) until the following items are addressed:

- **3 – Source;** Identify the source as “Wastewater” which is tributary of “Little Creek”
- **4 - Point of Diversion(s);** According to the map you provided, your property lies within the SWSW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 24, Twp 19N, Rge 01E. This information should be recorded on your application.
- **6 - Total Quantity;** Mark the total amount of water diverted. This should match the diversion you marked in item 5 (0.05 cfs). Note, you can divert up to 0.06 cfs for irrigation of 2.0 acres.
- **9 - Place of Use;** Using the legal description described above, mark the desired amount of irrigation use in acres in the appropriate box (SWSW) and fill in the Twp, Rge & Sec.
- **13 – Time;** Identify the time required to complete the diversion works and application of water to beneficial use. You may request any period from 1 to 5 years.

The original incomplete application is enclosed. Please make the necessary amendments to the original form and re-submit within the next thirty (30) days. If IDWR does not receive your written response within thirty (30) days, a refund will be issued for this filing. This letter is an attempt to ensure that your application is complete in order to establish a priority date. You may receive future correspondence regarding more specific details of your application.
