Attachment 8A – Water Balance

Industrial Water Demand Estimate

Industrial use is proposed for a meat packing facility that will process 500 – 600 cattle per day. The annual water demand for 600 head is estimated to be 545 af based on 950 gallons per day, 273 operating days, and 240,000 gpd on non-operating days. Allowing for contingency, a total annual volume for industrial use of 661.5 af is proposed.

Conversion of Water Right from Irrigation to Industrial Use

Because IDWR considers industrial use to be fully consumptive, to prevent enlargement when changing the nature of use of a right from irrigation to industrial, IDWR policy is to reduce the allowable diversion volume to the maximum consumptive use under the irrigation water right within the previous five-year period.

Table 1 provides an estimate of consumptive use on the property irrigated under water rights 36-2283 and 36-14617 from 2015 to 2019. Consumptive use is estimated based on the crops grown on the farm as reported to the USDA FSA, and precipitation deficit (Pdef) for each crop. Pdef values are obtained from the ET Idaho website using the Jerome weather station. Annual groundwater diversion volumes for the property, available from IDWR's WMIS database, are also provided in Table 1.

Inspection of Table 1 shows that the maximum diversion volume occurred in 2015. The calculated Pdef over the irrigated area (2.72 af/ac) and the diversion volume (3.12 af/ac) result in an unrealistic irrigation efficiency of 87%. It is likely that the consumptive use was less than predicted by the Pdef values if the crop was not fully watered. Assuming an irrigation efficiency of 80% for primarily center pivot irrigation on the Ford/Roth farm, and a diversion rate of 3.12 af/ac, a better estimate for actual consumptive use is 2.50 af/ac over the 347.06 irrigated area in 2015.

IDWR considers water rights 36-2283 and 63-14617 to be linked, requiring any transfer of one right to include a proportional transfer of the other right. Based on this requirement, a transfer of 70% of water rights 36-2283 and 63-14617 to industrial use at a rate of 2.50 af/ac is proposed resulting in 3.50 cfs (1570 gpm), 264.6 acres, and 661.5 af changed to industrial use to cover the processing plant's annual industrial needs. Place of use will be the proposed processing plant site plus the reuse areas on the Ford/Roth and Martin properties. Season of use will be changed to year-round.

An ESPA Transfer Spreadsheet model analysis and mitigation analysis are not required for transfers that propose to add a point of diversion in the same or adjacent model cell as the existing point of diversion.

On behalf of True West Beef LLC, enclosed please find two Applications for Transfer of Water Right and an Application for Temporary Approval of Water Use. The applications are summarized below.

The first transfer application proposes to retire 264.6 acres of irrigation and change the associated 3.5 cfs portions of water rights 36-2283 and 36-14617 from irrigation to industrial use. Based on an analysis of historical use, the volume proposed for industrial use is 661.5 acre feet (2.5 af/ac). Points of diversion will be two new wells. The new wells will be located in an ESPA model cell adjacent to the existing point of diversion model cell. As a result, an ETRANS analysis is not required.

The second transfer application proposes to create a permissible place of use for irrigation water rights 36-2386, 36-2608, and 36-16951 and the remaining 1.5 cfs and 113.4 acres of irrigation water rights 36-2283 and 36-14617. The points of diversion for all five rights will include the two wells currently serving 36-2386, 36-2608, and 36-16951 and the well currently serving 36-2283 and 36-14617. An ETRANS analysis determined that mitigation is not required for the proposed transfer.

The Application for Temporary Approval of Water Use seeks 5 acre feet of water for construction purposes. Point of diversion will be the well currently authorized for water rights 36-2283 and 36-14617.

Ownership of 36-2283 and 36-14617 was recently changed from ZV Trust to True West Beef. Ownership of 36-2386, 36-2608, and 36-16951 is still in the name of ZV Trust, but will be changed to True West Beef in the near future. A letter from ZV Trust authorizing True West Beef to submit the irrigation transfer is included.

A check for \$2420 is enclosed to cover the application filing fees.

- The industrial transfer fee is \$990 (\$740 for 3.5 cfs and \$250 for a change in nature of use).
- The irrigation transfer fee is \$1380 for 11.68 cfs.
- The temporary water use fee is \$50.

The \$2420 amount does not include fees to change the water right ownership for 36-2386, 36-2608, and 36-16951. A separate notice and associated fees will be submitted when ZV Trust conveys the lands associated with those rights to True West.
