**Narrative in Support of Application of Permit
Shovelback Holdings LLC**

Applicant owns the Red Rock Campground, nearby Henry’s Lake in Fremont County, Idaho and has recently purchased an adjacent parcel on which to expand the campground. This application proposes to obtain a new water right for non-consumptive use for the expansion onto the new parcel.

Existing Campground

Water rights #21-7360 and 21-13235 allow diversion of water for the non-consumptive uses associated with the existing campground, including RV sites, a cabin, an office, laundry facilities, and showers. In addition, water rights 21-13269 and 21-13270 authorize irrigation of a total of 6 acres across the existing campground. The majority of the 6 acres of irrigation are within the existing campground. The remainder of the irrigation acres are within the proposed POU.

Proposed Campground

It is proposed that the campground be enlarged an additional 80 RV sites, a laundry facility, and a shower facility. Below are two tables showing the calculations and justifications used to determine the diversion rate and volume required to operate the enlargement of the campground. The diversion rate proposed in the application is based upon a likely maximum instantaneous diversion rate. Average daily diversion rate will be less.

The quantities calculated for this new permit were determined using the water requirements of the expansion of the campground, by fixture or connection. Existing uses that are already covered by water rights are not included in these calculations.

Irrigation

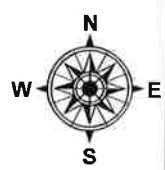
This application does not propose any irrigation. Water right 21-13269 overlaps the proposed place of use and authorizes irrigation of approximately 1.7 acres in the POU. A large portion of the expansion will be covered by roads, concrete pads and parking sites, and a 2-acre drain field. Applicant will use xeriscaping techniques to eliminate irrigation demand in some areas. Irrigation within the proposed POU will be limited to the existing water rights. No additional irrigation water rights are be required.
