We attempted to do an in-house field exam on this permit. However, upon review of the 2016 Google Earth imagery, the point of diversion appears to be at different location than what shown in the application for permit and permit maps. The point of diversion also appears to be close to an unnamed stream instead of a spring. With the concerns regarding the source and the location of the point of diversion, it would be best to go to the site to determine the actual source and point of diversion location. Therefore, I think it is prudent for the Northern Region staff to visit this site to confirm the source and point of diversion location before we issue a license.
