Fire Protection: This property is located in the far edge of Twin Falls County adjacent to B L M land and is not covered or protected by any rural fire department. We would need two water storage ponds with easy access to road and reasonably close to the two proposed homes. It would be necessary to have the water available year round for fire protection.

Wildlife: The amount of water requested is to have enough flow to keep the ponds healthy so that they will attract and support wildlife. We will need water year round so that the water level does not fluctuate, therefore creating a stable environment for the wildlife.

Aesthetics: The amount of flow requested is necessary to maintain the aesthetic qualities of the pond. Any amount less would create an ugly, algae filled, stagnant, mosquito breeding pond.

Remarks: On August 25, 1998 I was granted a permit to Appropriate Water from the State of Idaho (copy attached) the source of water supply being ground water. Subsequently an expert on developing and sustaining healthy pond systems has advised me to refile my application and ask for the Snake river to be the source of water supply so that we will be able to pump water from the river and return it back to the river and therefore recirculate the water in the pond occasionally without impacting the underground aquifer. This will still remain a non consumptive use of the water for fire protection, wildlife enhancement and aesthetics and we will take precautions not to change or impact the shoreline of the Snake River.

I would like to thank the Idaho Department of Water Resources and especially Mr. Shelly Keen for his patience in working through this problem with me.

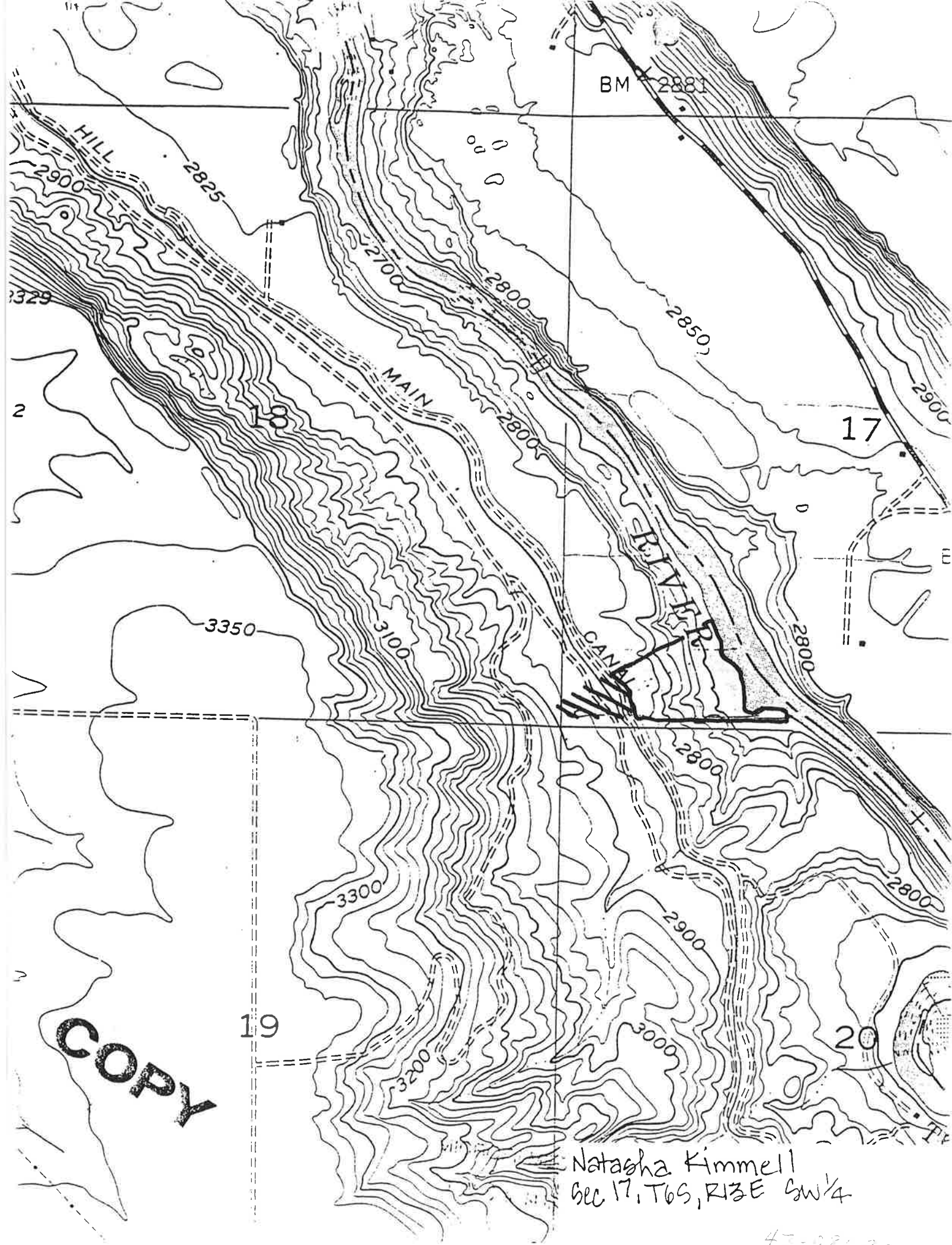

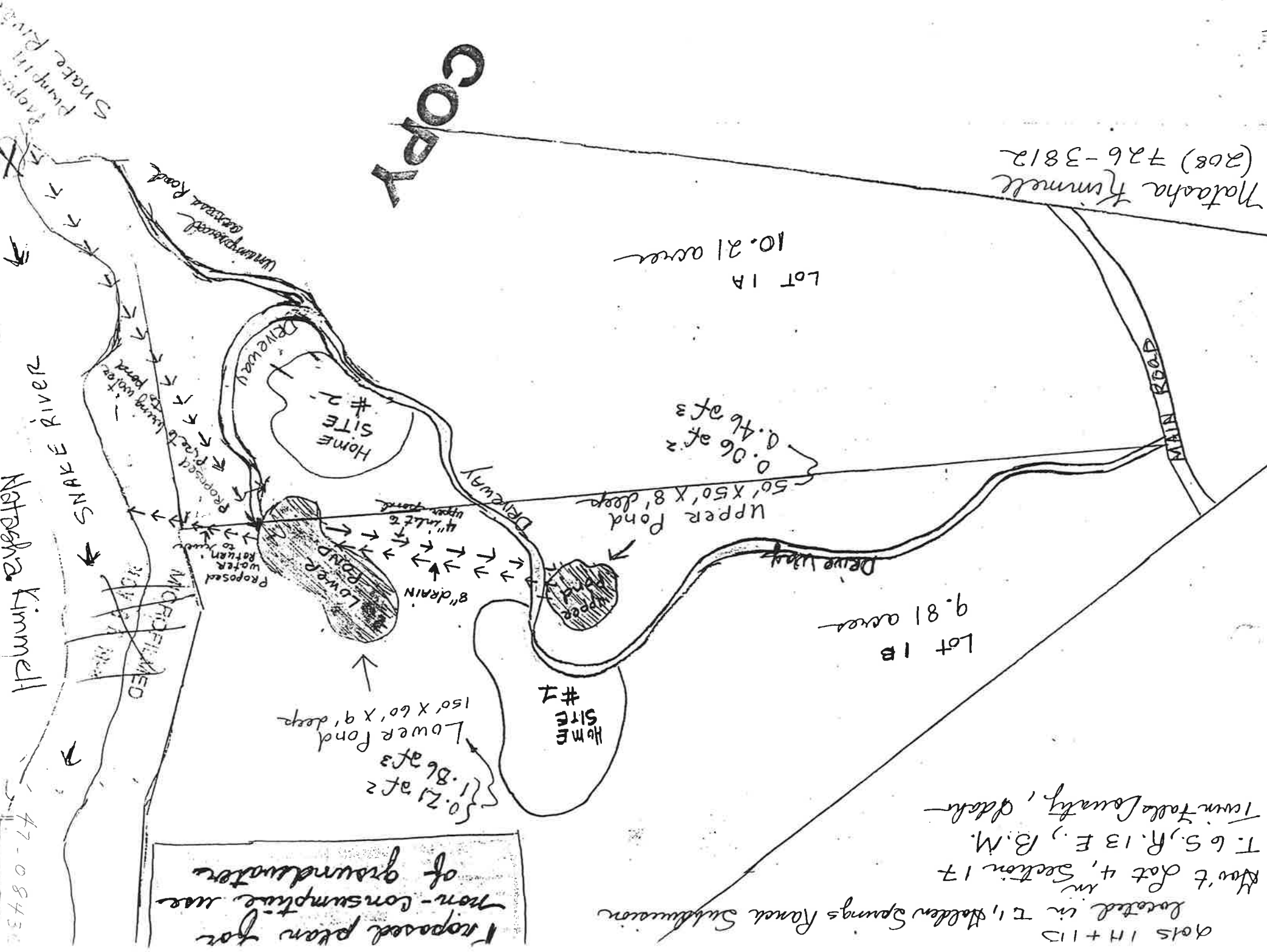

Georgia,

I think we can leave the groundwater permit in place. It will lapse if she does not submit proof. If she does develop some of it, she can submit proof and get a license for what she's done. The main issue was to keep her from continuously pumping groundwater straight into the river (almost) and out of the basin in an area where we're trying to protect/conservate the groundwater. She decided the conditions on the groundwater permit were too restrictive for her needs. Maybe she'll develop some combination of groundwater and surface water use.

Good morning. I rcvd. a new application for permit from Natasha, and another check for \$100.00. This application is filled out exactly like the permit 47-08426 with the exception of the source, i.e. Snake River instead of the groundwater.

In her remarks, she thanked you for guiding her in the way she needed to go. Before I make a move on this, I wanted to confer with you. The Snake Rvr Basin Moratorium allows storage from surface if non-consumptive use and reservoir surface area does not exceed 1/2 acre, which appears to be approximately 0.3 acre. If we are to process the new application, does the record need to show a withdrawal/cancel of the current permit? Again, thanks for your help, it is a pleasure to work with you. GLS

SUBJECT: Review and Recommendation

This application propose to develop two (2) ponds for wildlife, aesthetics & fire protection. The source of water for the ponds is proposed to be a new cold water well (Groundwater). The size of the ponds (2.4 af capacity with 0.27 acre surface area) is insignificant with total consumptive use less than the domestic exemption. For this reason the application was processed as non-consumptive. The site is located adjacent to the Snake River on the SW side of the river in Twin Falls County and in an area where deep hot water aquifers are known to exist. The site is also near areas where landslides have been problems in the past. The application proposes to divert 0.5 cfs from the new well through the ponds and then discharging the water into the Snake River.

## ANALYSIS

Although the total use may be insignificant the rate of diversion seems excessive. A review of the draft memo for "Evaluating Recreational Fish Ponds" 6/20/92 may justify the 0.5 cfs for a refill rate of pond volume every 2 days which is consistent with trout but if warm water fish are planted the 0.5 cfs may not be justified. The application appears to propose a one time flow through of water with discharge into the Snake River. It does not appear that re-circulation through the ponds has been considered.

I recommend that this application be reviewed by administrators and the groundwater hydrology section for the purpose of assessing the diversion rate and conditioning the permit.

I recommend that the following conditions be considered:

- The use is non-consumptive to the basin to the extent that the groundwater and Snake River water is not depleted. The director retains jurisdiction to determine future injury to other water rights and may require future mitigation.
- A measuring device be installed at the point of diversion with totalizing meter and use reported annually to the department.
- Other county, state and federal approvals may be required (DEQ discharge permit, SCA permit for discharge site)
- To minimize water use of groundwater a re-circulation system between ponds must be incorporated in design. Use of groundwater is authorized for filling and maintaining pond levels. Continuous discharge of well into Snake River is not authorized.

The application for a permit in the name of Natasha Kimmell proposes to drill a well that will be used to fill two ponds that are for non-consumptive uses. Both ponds have a total surface area of 0.27 acre and the proposed uses are storage for wildlife, aesthetics, and fire protection.

The point of diversion is in Lot 4 of the SESW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T06S, R13E. The places of use are all in Lot 4, however, it appears the ponds will be in both SESW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SWSW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, T06S, R13E.

The applicant states, in the future, there will be two other wells drilled for the two homes. We discussed the limitations of a domestic well in compliance with §42-111.

Conditions of Approval:

- Subject to all prior water rights.
- The well to be drilled must comply with the §42-235, IDAHO CODE.
- The well must have a measuring device with totalizing meter installed to measure the diversion from the well.

SUBJECT: Review and Recommendation

This application propose to develop two (2) ponds for wildlife, aesthetics & fire protection. The source of water for the ponds is proposed to be the Snake River. (THIS PERMIT SHOULD BE RE-NUMBERED WITH A BASIN 02 NUMBER) Permit 47-08426 was issued for the same development out of groundwater. The groundwater permit had several conditions that were not acceptable to the applicant.

The size of the ponds (2.4 af capacity with 0.27 acre surface area) is insignificant with total consumptive use less than the domestic exemption. For this reason the application was processed as non-consumptive. The application proposes to divert 0.5 cfs from the Snake River and run it through the ponds and then discharge back into the Snake River. The application was intended to mirror 47-08426 except the diversion to storage was left off which I added back in. This was not advertised but I do not think it warrents re-advertising.

#### ANALYSIS

I recommend that the permit be approved subject to the following conditions:

- The use is non-consumptive to the basin to the extent that the Snake River water is not depleted. The director retains jurisdiction to determine future injury to other water rights and may require future mitigation.
- A measuring device be installed at the point of diversion with totalizing meter and use reported annually to the department.
- Other county, state and federal approvals may be required (DEQ discharge permit, SCA permit for discharge site)
- This permit combined with 47-08426 is limited to 0.5 cfs diverted to storage at any one time and a total storage volume of 2.4 af.
