Gentlemen:

This letter is a request for refund of the application fee paid for 47-8303 in the amount of \$30.00 and the drilling permit fee in the amount of \$200.00 relating to the well that was to be drilled under permit 47-8303. Both of these fees were receipted under receipt S014446, a copy of which is attached.

Rogers N.K. Seed Co. has withdrawn Application for Permit #47-8303. It has been determined that substantially less water is needed in our seed cleaning operation than requested under the application and it will be more economical to use an existing well than to drill a new one. Also, the current moratorium on new groundwater development will curtail the development of a new well and system and the existing system can be utilized almost immediately.

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. _____, and said application is hereby _____.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:
