1. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before May 3, 1993.
2. Subject to all prior water rights.
3. Project construction shall commence within one year from the date of permit issuance and shall proceed diligently to completion unless it can be shown to the satisfaction of the Director of the Department of Water Resources that delays were due to circumstances over which permit holder had no control.
4. Any license issued by IDWR pursuant to the permit or portion thereof for the use of trust water is subject to a term review of 20 years after the date of this approval to determine availability of water for the use and to re-evaluate the public interest at the end of the term.
5. Diversion and use of water under this permit is subject to an annual use fee if rules are subsequently promulgated which provide for the submittal of the fee.
6. The Director retains jurisdiction of the permit and/or subsequent license issued to change, add or remove any requirement as determined to be appropriate.
7. The rate of diversion of water for irrigation under this permit and all other water rights on the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.

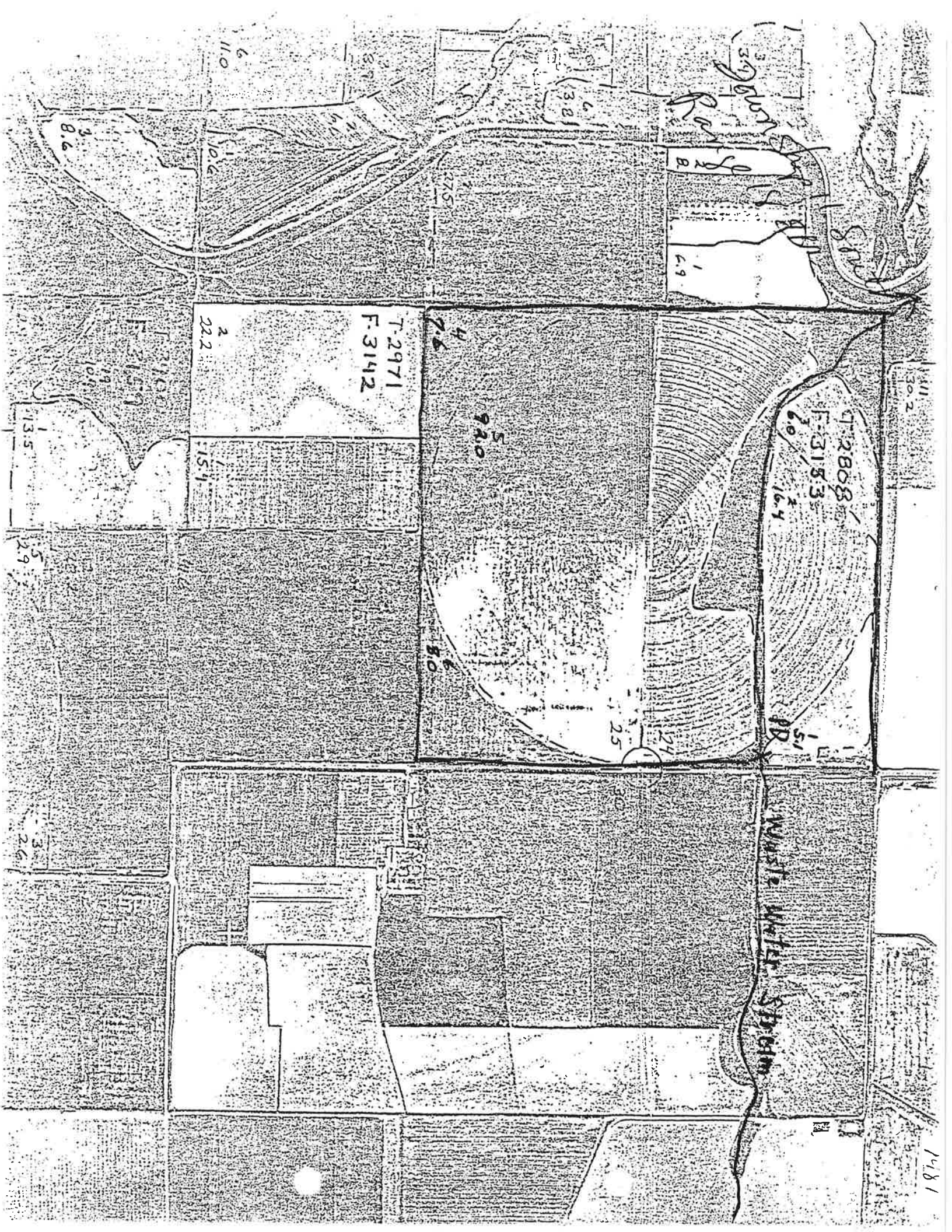
