



Dear Applicant,

On May 22, 2020, the Idaho Department of Water Resources (Department) received transfer application no. 84109 and applications for amendment of permit for water nos. 63-34308, 63-33207, and 63-34385 all in the name of CS Property Development LLC. This letter serves two purposes — (i.) returning your application for amendment of permit no. 63-34308 and (ii.) requesting additional information regarding your transfer application no. 84109.

Water right no. 63-34308 is a decreed water right, not a water permit. Decreed water rights cannot be changed through an amendment of permit. The Department is returning application for amendment of permit no. 63-34308 to you at this time and will refund you the \$100.00 application processing fee.

After an initial review of transfer application 84109, the Department determined the application cannot be processed until the following items are addressed:

- Concern of enlargement in unstacking water rights:

Water rights are considered stacked "when two or more water rights, generally of different priorities and often from different sources, are used for the same use and overlie the same place of use" (Transfer Processing Memo 24-5(d) (3)). The four water rights listed on your transfer application are historically stacked with six other water rights (63-34303, 63-34305, 63-34306, 63-34309, 63-34311, and 63-34312). Your transfer proposes changing the POU of water rights 63-34304, 63-34307, 63-34308, and 63-34310 without changing the POU for the other six stacked irrigation rights within this stacked group. The POU transfer for these four water rights exclusively is concerning to the Department as "unstacking" is presumed to enlarge some or all of the water rights within a stacked group.

Supplemental ground water irrigation rights generally cannot be transferred to a place of use (POU) without surface water:

Supplemental irrigation rights are "stacked water right(s) authorizing the diversion of water for irrigation from a secondary source to provide a full supply for crops when used in combination with a primary right" (Transfer Processing Memo 24-5(d) (4)). Your transfer proposes to change the POU and point of diversion (POD) of water rights 63-34304, 63-34307, 63-34308, and 63-34310. These four water rights are all "supplemental ground water rights" and thus can only be used as secondary sources in conjunction with primary surface water rights within a common POU. In other words, the four rights listed in your transfer cannot be used to irrigate an area of land if that land is lacking surface water irrigation rights. The POU your transfer proposes does not currently have surface irrigation rights nor does your transfer currently propose changing the POU of CS Property LLC's surface water irrigation rights (63-34303 & 63-34312).

The Department cannot process your transfer application until you provide sufficient evidence that (i.) surface water will be available for irrigation at your proposed POU and (ii.) this transfer will not result in enlargement of any water right due to unstacking historically stacked water rights. How you wish to proceed with this transfer application is ultimately up to you.
