
B.1 Riverside's water rights are listed on the attached Spreadsheet including the right numbers, amounts, nature of use, period of use, source and tributary do not change.

B.2 Riverside proposes to expand the boundaries of its place of use to incorporate approximately 90 additional acres. Based on IDWR procedures, Riverside understands that adding 90 acres to the boundary involves moving water rights in the amount of 90 acres/10,158 acres or less than 1% of Riverside's water rights. Riverside's water rights total 723.26 cfs. Applying that ratio to the total water rights equals 6.4 cfs technically being "moved."

B.4 The additional acres included in the existing place of use are located in T5N R5W § 35, approximately 30 acres in NWNE, 38 acres in SENE and 22 acres in NESE. See Attachment #7b.
