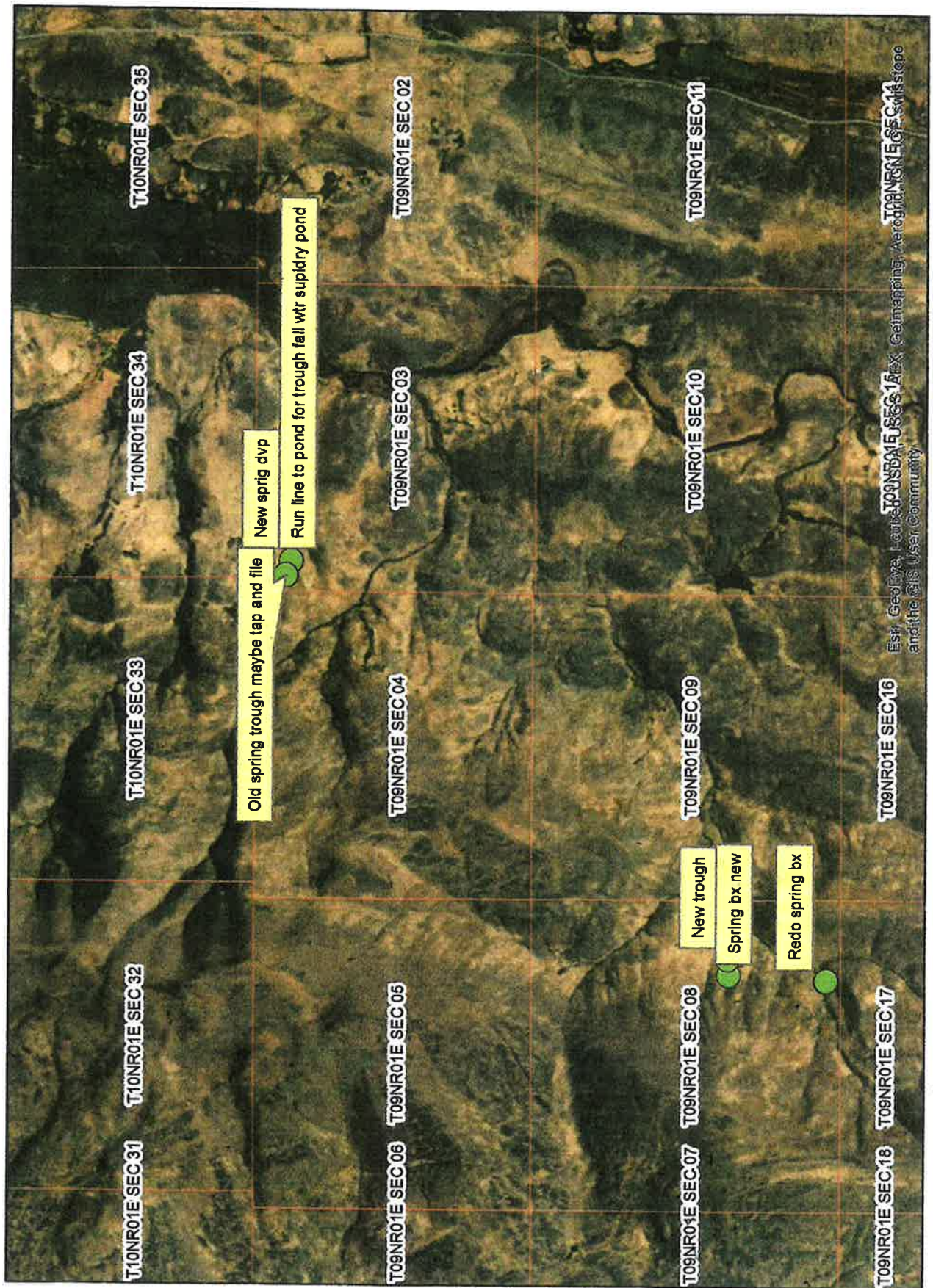

Re: Water Right Application Incomplete - Returned

Dear Applicant:

This office received your application on May 28, 2020. The application cannot be accepted into the records of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) until the following items are addressed:

- **3 – Source:** Identify a tributary. If the springs feed into an unnamed stream then mark as such. If the springs flow to the surface but sink back into the ground after any length, the mark “sinks” as the tributary.
- **4 - Point of Diversion(s):** The application requires you to mark the correct quarter-quarter down to the 10 acre tract.
- **5 – Water Use:** Specify your beneficial use. It seems you are requesting water for Stockwater purposes (80 cattle and 4 horses). If this is correct, I recommend a diversion rate of 0.03 cfs for Stockwater purposes from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31.
- **6 - Total Quantity**
- **7 - Description of the Diverting Works:** Mark how the water passes through the pipe; gravity or pumped, etc.
- **9 - Place of Use:** Like the point of diversion, you must describe the place of use, or where the stock would drink at. You can mark the appropriate quarter-quarter using the “X” symbol.
- **11b – Ownership:** Who owns the land or place of use?
- **12 – Description in narrative form**
- **13 – Time:** How many years will it take to accomplish beneficial use?

The original incomplete application is enclosed. For your convenience, I have included a map that may help identify the specific 10 ac description. I have also included instructions to help you complete the form. Please make the necessary amendments to the original form and re-submit within the next thirty (30) days. If IDWR does not receive your written response within thirty (30) days, a refund will be issued for this filing. This letter is an attempt to ensure that your application is complete in order to establish a priority date. You may receive future correspondence regarding more specific details of your application.
