 Evidence of Water Right Ownership: Notarized copy of Deed, Title Policy, Contract of Sale, or other legal document indicating your ownership of the property and/or water rights in question.

During our review of the documentation you submitted we found discrepancies between that documentation and the legal description of the place of use for the water right(s) indicated in your notice.
