



Re: Review & Evaluation of Sufficiency of Information

Background:

Christopher Tambe filed an Application for Transfer of Water Right on August 19, 2019 to change the place of use (POU). In Part I, item A.2, the Mr. Tambe states that the place of use was decreed incorrectly, and that the use "remains as claimed in SRBA and has not changed".

The initial claim for this water right was filed in the Snake River Basin Adjudication (SRBA) by Lorrain N. or Calvin W. Barrett. Paul and Margaret Hennig filed a change of ownership for the claim in 2006, prior to the recommendation of the claim. At the time of recommendation, Mr. Hennig filed a notice of error that shifted the POU to the south to include 0.2 acres of the NWNE of Section 4, Township 23N, Range 22E. Mr. Hennig appears to have based his decision on the alignment of the satellite imagery of the property with the PLS boundaries as represented in the map provided by the Department for the SRBA Recommendation. The final decree for the water right agrees with the change requested by Mr. Hennig, but disagrees with the location of the property as described in the deeds of ownership.

According to the documents for the original claim, the Barretts based the location of the POU on their deed for the property. The metes and bounds of the deed place the entire property within the SWSE of Section 33, Township 24N, Range 22E. Mr. Tambe filed a change of ownership for the water right on August 19, 2019, which included a copy of his deed for the property. The deed records the sale of the property from Paul and Margaret Hennig to Christopher Tambe, and has the same metes and bounds as the deed for the Barretts. On September 26, 2019, I sent an email to Mr. Tambe requesting a copy of the deed of ownership of the property for the Hennigs, who completed the claim in the SRBA. Mr. Tambe submitted a copy of the requested deed to the Salmon Field Office (IDWR), which was forwarded to me by email on September 30, 2019. The deed of ownership of the property for the Hennigs has the same metes and bounds as the other two deeds mentioned above.

This transfer will be processed as a correction to the POU. The original claim and subsequent deeds on file all describe the property boundaries with the same metes and bounds within the SWSE of Section 33, Township 24N, Range 22E. Based on the information provided, the place of use appears to have always been in the SWSE of Section 33. The alignment of satellite imagery with PLS data is not a reliable source for determining location information, and should not have been used to make corrections to the claim.

A transfer to correct the location description of the POU does not need to be advertised. The Department did send a notification of the proposed change to water right 75-10504 to Joel R. Griffith, who is the owner of the property in the NWNE of Section 4, Township 23N, Range 22E. I sent a letter to Mr. Griffith on October 8, 2019, informing him of the proposed transfer, and requested any comments he may have. Mr. Griffith was given 14 days to respond to the letter. As of the date of this memo, Mr. Griffith has not provided a response to the letter.

Authority to File:

Mr. Tambe is the owner of record for the water right, and signed the application for transfer. Mr. Tambe paid the \$50 dollar filing fee for this type of transfer, according to I.C. § 42-221 (O.8).

Water Right Validity:

The water right is presumed to be valid. The right was decreed in 2008. The tax parcel that contains the POU is 0.5 acres, which includes the location of the home. Satellite imagery indicates that the majority of the property has been regularly irrigated since before the time the water right was decreed. After rounding to the nearest tenth of an acre, the total number of acres irrigated may be equal to 0.5 acres.

Injury to Other Water Rights:

The location description of the POU is the only proposed change. The point of diversion (POD), POU, and nature of use will remain the same. If the transfer is approved, there should be no injury to other water rights.

Enlargement of Use:

This transfer proposes only to correct to the POU description. There is no risk of enlargement of use.

Local Public Interest:

The claim to this water right was reviewed and decreed as part of the SRBA. The proposed transfer is assumed to be in the local public interest based on the SRBA decision and recognition of the water right.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources:

The application proposes beneficial uses consistent with conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Effect on Economy the Local Area:

This transfer proposes only to correct to the POU description, and should have no effect on the local economy.

Effect on Agricultural Base of the Local Area:

The transfer proposes to correct the location description of the POU of an existing use. If the transfer is approved there should be no effect on the local agricultural base.

Review of the application finds there is no clear inconsistency with criteria set forth in Section 42-222 Idaho Code preventing processing of this application.

You may need to contact the county assessor to get instrument number for the deed, and then contact the county recorder for the copy of the deed.

The Department has a copy of the deed when the Barretts purchased the property and a copy of your deed from your purchase of the property from the Hennigs. A copy of the deed from when the Hennigs purchased the property from the Barretts will complete the chain of records for the ownership of your property, and will help to provide evidence of the location of the water use of 75-10504. I have recommended that these be submitted with the reduced \$50 fee per water right. There are no physical changes proposed on any of these. Please be on the lookout for them and let me know if you have any questions or issues processing as corrections.

Fourth of July Ck – will be filed in the name of Bellamy (75-14641, 119) and Dougherty (75-14313, 14641). They should all come in together. PODs for four right are way off. Dougherty and I both collected GIS coordinates for the correct pod locations, and his were better so he's supposed to send that info. If he does not, I have it. Bellamy also has POU corrections on 75-119 and 120. I have the shape files for both corrected irrigation pous, and am happy to send that to the reviewing agent.

Tower Creek – POU transfer and ownership change filed in the name of Tambe. Hint – look in the claim file and at the submitted warranty deed. Lemhi Co parcel layer is way off in this area. The metes and bounds puts the entire property in the correct location in SWSE S33. During claim review it appears someone mistook a parcel line for a section line, and part of this recommendation landed in Sec 4 where it doesn't belong it. The claim was filed correctly in SWSE, albeit for too many acres (5 as opposed to 0.5). Total 0.5 acres is correct.
