Hi Dan,

The permitted volumes were based on design excavation plans.

A few of the pond 'footprints' were smaller, and one a little larger, than plans used in the permit process. When I talked with the owner/developer on this, I understand that pond depths were as planned with a few adjustments to the surface area. I felt it appropriate to use the permitted & designed volume/(area x max depth) ratio to adjust recommended volume when aerial extent had changed. Attached is the spreadsheet.
