RECITALS

- 1. The Board is authorized under chapter 17, title 42, Idaho Code to operate a water supply bank and to contract with lessors to act as an intermediary in facilitating the rental of water.
- 2. The Lessor has filed a completed application to lease water rights described below into the Water Supply Bank on forms supplied by the Idaho Department of Water Resources and received by the Department on May 11, 2020.
- 3. The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources has reviewed the application for compliance with the Water Supply Bank rules and has approved the Lease subject to conditions listed below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and contracts herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **WATER RIGHTS**: The Lessor shall lease and the Board shall accept into the Bank the Applicant's water rights described as follows:

2. **COMPENSATION**: The Lessor shall accept and the Board shall pay compensation determined by the amount of water rented under the following rental rate during such times as the water is rented from the Bank over the term of this Lease.

Minimum Payment Acceptable: Current Rental Rate

- 3. **TERM OF LEASE**: The term of this lease shall be January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2021. This Lease shall bind the parties and take effect when both parties have signed it.
- 4. WATER SUPPLY BANK CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE: The Lessor shall abide by all terms and conditions contained in the Water Supply Bank Conditions of Acceptance, attached hereto as "Attachment A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

- 5. CHANGE OF WATER RIGHT: This lease specifies water right elements including but not limited to: diversion rates; diversion volumes; number of acres authorized to be irrigated; places of use; points of diversion; beneficial uses; and seasons of use. During the term of this lease, if a water right is administratively changed due to a water right split and renumbering, this lease may be reduced by an equal amount to reflect the water right elements as legally defined under the water right. If a lease contract cannot be reduced sufficient to reflect the legal definition of a water right as amended through a water right split and/or water right transfer, the Board may release the water right from the Water Supply Bank.
- 6. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT: This lease is between the Board and the Lessor, who is the recognized owner or designated representative of the recognized owners of water rights described herein. Should ownership of any part of a water right herein described change during the term of this lease, either through a water right split, a water right transfer, sale of property to which the water right is appurtenant, or through any other recognized water right reassignment, the lease benefits and obligations to the conditions of acceptance for any such water rights will be assigned to the new owners.
- 7. **DUPLICATE ORIGINAL**: This Lease is executed in duplicate. Each of the documents with an original signature of each party shall be an original.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate.
- 2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.
- 3. While a right is in the bank, the lessor may <u>not</u> use the right without approval of the Department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-351 for illegal diversion and use of water and may include civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701B.
- 4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, or the lease term expires. A right may be released from the bank upon request, provided the Board approves the release. Unless approved by the Department, leased rights may not be immediately available for release.
- 5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-223(5).
- 6. Rental of water under this right is subject to the limitations and conditions of approval of the water right.
- 7. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.
- 8. Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other Department application process.
- 9. In accordance with Idaho Code § 42-248 and § 42-1409(6), all owners of water rights are required to notify the Department of any changes in mailing address or change in ownership of all or part of a water right. Notice must be provided within 120 days of the change.
- 10. If a water right leased into the Water Supply Bank is sold or conveyed during the lease term, and if the leased right was rented, the rental proceeds will be disbursed in the following manner regardless of any arrangements between the buyer(s) and seller(s) to the contrary:
 - a. Rental payments will go to the lessor(s) of record at the beginning of the rental season, even if the Department processes a Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership during the rental season.
 - b. New lessor(s) of record will receive payment for any subsequent rental seasons.
- 11. The water right(s) is leased to the bank subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
- 12. The unleased portion of right 61-12354 is limited to the irrigation of 2.1 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
- 13. The unleased portion of right 61-12355 is limited to the irrigation of 2.6 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
- 14. The unleased portion of right 61-12356 is limited to the irrigation of 1.3 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
- 15. The unleased portion of right 61-12357 is limited to the irrigation of 0.4 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
- 16. The unleased portion of right 61-12358 is limited to the irrigation of 2.2 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.


- 17. The unleased portion of right 61-12359 is limited to the irrigation of 2.5 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
- 18. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 19. The unleased portions of water rights 61-12354, 61-12355, 61-12356, 61-12357, 61-12358 and 61-12359 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.15 cfs, a total annual maximum diversion volume of 40 af for the irrigation of 10.0 acres in a single irrigation season.
- 20. Water rights 61-12354, 61-12355, 61-12356, 61-12357, 61-12358 and 61-12359 shall be subordinated to 61-12090 in the event of priority administration of water rights with points of diversion within administrative Basin 61.
- 21. Water rights 61-12354, 61-12355, 61-12356, 61-12357, 61-12358 and 61-12359 shall be subordinated to 63-32499 in the event of priority administration of water rights with points of diversion within administrative Basin 63.
- 22. Use of water under this agreement may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No 161.
- 23. The right holder shall install or construct a straight length of conduit or ditch suitable for installation of a device for measuring the entire flow of water being diverted in connection with this right. If the right holder uses conduit, the straight length of conduit shall be at least fifteen times the diameter of the conduit and shall be above ground or otherwise easily accessible.
- 24. Diversion and use of water in connection with this right is subject to a Monitoring-Reporting Plan. The right holder shall provide the Department with a plan for monitoring-reporting aquifer levels, diversion flow rates, and volumes. The monitoring-reporting should occur in parallel with land development and production and should include identification of non-production wells and timelines for measuring and reporting. The right holder shall not divert water in connection with this right until the plan is approved by the Department. Failure to comply with the plan once it is accepted shall be cause for the Department to cancel or revoke the right.
- 25. The diversion and use of water described in Transfer 78356 may be subject to additional conditions and limitations agreed to by the protestant and the right holder under a separate agreement to which the Department is not a party. Because the Department is not a party, the Department is not responsible for enforcement of any aspect of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions herein. Enforcement of those portions of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions shall be the responsibility of the protestant and the water right holder.
- 26. This right does not grant any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
- 27. Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.





Re: Water Supply Bank Lease Application 1723

Purpose/Narrative: An application was received by the Department May 11, 2020 on behalf of Mr. Paul and Ms. Shelia Hudson. The application is intended to both protect a portion of their acreage from forfeiture while facilitating a rental for Mr. Duane Amyx such that the fullest possible extent of the prior PPU can be irrigated.

Prior to the Hudsons taking ownership, the water right had covered the entire area being proposed for both the lease and rental packages. During the split the water right was divided between the interested parties based on the proportion owned. This left a discrepancy in the amounts available for each part, making irrigation of the full extent of each portion difficult. This purpose of the lease/rental package is to correct this oversight.

Authority to File: The application was signed by both Paul and Shelia Hudson and submitted by their representative at Idaho Water Engineering. IDWR records indicate they are the current water right holder. No concerns at this time

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water rights being leased have recently been transferred to a new place of use with an updated point of diversion as well.

From a review of the water rights being offered and the associated permit, this is the fifth year that the applicant has in which to complete the transfer. Because this is a transfer of an existing water right, the applicant only has to prove that the change in place of use and point of diversion has been accomplished. With the construction of the diversion works it would appear that the transfer has been accomplished and the water rights can be protected.

Injury Evaluation: During the review of the transfer application is was determined that the use of water at this location would not cause injury. Because the lease application is seeking to idle acres that could otherwise be irrigated, no injury is apparent through this contract. No concerns at this time.

Enlargement of Use: No enlargement is evident through the lease. Through this package the applicant intends to irrigate approximately 10 acres while protecting the remainder, making it available for Mr. Amyx.

No concerns at this time. The number of acres and composition for and viluous were adjusted from what wis applied for pressure the control and villace control acres of the original water rights.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the lease.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The lease appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: IDWR Western Region comments were requested on

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Based on the information presented by the applicant, staff recommend the application be approved through 2021.
