

The Idaho Department of Water Resources is returning your application for additional information.

On the location of the source and points of diversion you need to be more specific. For instance, Lake Coeur d' Alene you need to identify where the points of diversion are, such as specific boat ramps, etc. Also, you list "other public surface waters", these need to be identified. Some water sources, late in the season, may not have sufficient water to supply your needs, as well as existing water right holders.
