This matter having come before the Department of Water Resources (Department) as a result of an application to transfer water rights, the Department finds, concludes, and orders as follows:

SUPPORT DATA

FINDINGS OF FACT

IN FILE # 57-123

- On November 12, 2019, Gary G. King applied to the Department for authorization to add a point of diversion for 0.78 cubic feet per second of water diverted from Castle Creek for irrigation purposes in Owyhee County in accordance with decreed Water Rights 57-123 and 57-220B. The application for transfer, designated no. 83755 by the Department, proposes the new point of diversion in the SE½NW¼, Section 35, Township 04 South, Range 01 East, B.M.
- 2. On November 18, 2019, the Department mailed Gary G. King a letter asking him to provide additional information and/or to modify the application for transfer to address concerns over validity/forfeiture of the water rights involved in the proposed transfer.
- 3. On December 11, 2019, the Department received a response from Gary G. King outlining his defense to the Department's forfeiture concerns. Mr. King noted the land, "had been neglected for several years", and that "most of the historically irrigated acreage had reverted back to native greasewood." Further, Mr. King clarified he needs the new point of diversion, "to fully resume use of the two water rights listed on the transfer application."
- 4. On April 14, 2020, the Department mailed Gary G. King a letter asking him to provide additional information to support his defense to forfeiture and protect against enlargement. In the letter, the Department informed Gary G. King that if he did not respond to the request within 30 days, the Department would reject his application for transfer.
- 5. The Department has not received a response from Gary G. King to the request for additional information and/or modification of Application for Transfer No. 83755.

APPLICABLE STATUTES

- 1. Idaho Code§ 42-222(1) states that a person "entitled to the use of water" may apply to the Department to change certain elements of the authorized water use.
- 2. Idaho Code § 42-222(1) also sets forth the criteria for evaluating an application for transfer of water rights:

The director of the department of water resources shall examine all the evidence and available information and shall approve the change in whole, or in part, or upon conditions, provided no other water rights are injured thereby, the change does not constitute an enlargement in use of the original right, the change is consistent with the conservation of water resources within the state of Idaho and is in the local public interest as defined in section 42-202B, Idaho Code, the change will not adversely affect the local economy of the watershed or local area within which the source of water for the proposed use originates, in the case where the place of use is outside of the watershed or local area where the source of water originates, and the new use is a beneficial use, which in the case of a municipal provider shall be satisfied if the water right is necessary to serve reasonably anticipated future needs as provided in this chapter. The director may consider consumptive use, as defined in section 42-202B, Idaho Code, as a factor in determining whether a proposed change would constitute an enlargement in use of the original water right.

3. Idaho Code§ 42-222(2) states:

All rights to the use of water acquired under this chapter or otherwise shall be lost and forfeited by a failure for the term of five (5) years to apply it to the beneficial use for which it was appropriated and when any right to the use of water shall be lost through nonuse or forfeiture such rights to such water shall revert to the state and be again subject to appropriation under this chapter; except that any right to the use of water shall not be lost through forfeiture by the failure to apply the water to beneficial use under certain circumstances as specified in section 42-223, Idaho Code.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

When evaluating a transfer application, the Department first determines whether the applicant is "entitled to the use of water" as required by Idaho Code Idaho Code§ 42-222(1). The Department interprets this requirement to mean that the water right(s) proposed to be changed must be valid. To determine water right validity, the Department requires evidence of a license, claim, or decree. The Department then applies the forfeiture provisions of Idaho Code§ 42-222(2). If the water rights proposed to be changed are not valid, the proposed change cannot be approved, and any further analysis is moot. If the water rights proposed to be changed are valid, the Department applies the transfer evaluation criteria in Idaho Code§ 42-222(1).

- 1. Without the additional information requested from Gary G. King, the Department cannot verify that the water rights proposed to be changed are valid, or that that the proposed change would not constitute an enlargement in use of the original water right.
- 2. The Department should reject Application for Transfer No. 83755.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Application for Transfer No. 83755 in the name of Gary G. King is REJECTED without prejudice.

EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. <u>It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:</u>

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. Note: the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

- (a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or
- (b) The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.

APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, if this preliminary order becomes final, any party aggrieved by the final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal the final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

The appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of this preliminary order becoming final. See section 67-5273, Idaho Code. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.

The Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) is currently reviewing the above referenced application for transfer to change a water right(s). After initial review of the application, IDWR sent you a letter on November 18, 2019 regarding concerns over validity of the right. On December 11, 2019 you submitted a defense to forfeiture stating that the land has been neglected for several years and that access to a new point of diversion is needed to fully resume use. I am contacting you today to notify you that the transfer application would likely be denied if processed as filed due to forfeiture concerns.

Forfeiture is a concern because using remote sensing technologies, the Department has concluded that beneficial use of the rights being transferred have not occurred for a period of 5 or more consecutive years. If the rights cannot be put to beneficial use from their original Point of Diversions (POD's), changing the point of diversion to a more available source poses a risk of enlargement of the right. Enlargement will occur if the total diversion rate, volume, or extent of beneficial use exceeds the amounts or beneficial use authorized under the water rights prior to the proposed transfer. This action includes changing a point of diversion to a new location where the water available is greater or more reliable.

You may wish to withdraw your application and resume the use at the original POD in order to avoid potential forfeiture of the right. IDWR will hold further processing of your application to allow a withdrawal or any other information you may wish to submit in support of your existing proposal.

Please submit the withdrawal form or additional information towards defense for application processing to continue. You may seek additional time to provide the information. Your written must be received within the next thirty (30) days.

Without a timely reply, IDWR will issue a preliminary order to deny the application. The application fee will not be refunded for a denied application. A denied application cannot generally be re-filed for substantially the same proposal.

Most of the historically irrigated acreage had reverted back to native greasewood. Since I have taken over the property, I have reclaimed most of the acres from natural vegetation. However, 2018 was not a good enough water year to fully irrigate the property. I need approval of the new point of diversion to fully resume use of the two water rights listed on the transfer application. Even though the climate engine NDVI data does not show full irrigation of the property you can still make out my attempts to irrigate using a new pivot system and gate pipe (see attached map).
















Dear Applicant:

On November 12, 2019, you filed a transfer application #83755 to add a diversion point for water rights 57-123 & 57-220B. Part of the transfer process is review for rights subject to forfeiture. Idaho Statute 42-222 states in part:

... (2) All rights to the use of water acquired under this chapter or otherwise shall be lost and forfeited by a failure for the term of five (5) years to apply it to the beneficial use for which it was appropriated and when any right to the use of water shall be lost through nonuse or forfeiture such rights to such water shall revert to the state and be again subject to appropriation under this chapter; except that any right to the use of water shall not be lost through forfeiture by the failure to apply the water to beneficial use under certain circumstances as specified in section 42-223, Idaho Code.

I am now trying to verify the water use on your land. The rights described above authorize a total irrigation of 41 acres. Using aerial imagery and digital tools to measure irrigated lands found a surface area of 22.6 acres. Remote sensing tools from satellites in 2014 to 2018 were used to show the areas described as fallow within your application may be subject to forfeiture. Evidence of irrigation use in these areas is needed to complete processing of the transfer application.

Please submit the requested information for the application to be processed. You may seek additional time to provide the information by making a written request to interrupt processing for up to six months. The application may be approved with partial forfeiture or rejected without a timely written reply within the next thirty (30) days. Refunds are not issued for rejected applications. You may also withdraw the application with the form enclosed in order to receive a refund for the filing. Please contact me at 208-334-2190 if you need more information.
