RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements
 of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not
 preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application
 process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. This right does not grant any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
- 10. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.
- 11. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 12. Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 120.
- 13. Upon specific notification of the Department, the renter shall install and maintain data loggers to record water usage information at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications.

- 14. Prior to the diversion and use of water under this rental agreement, the renter shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device(s) at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications, or shall obtain an approved variance from the Department to determine the amount of water diverted from power records or to maintain an existing measuring device.
- 15. Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.







Purpose/Narrative: An application was received from Mr. Michael Taylor on April 23, 2020 in response to a second NOV (E2019-1378) issued by the Department for unauthorized place of use expansion. Mr. Taylor has submitted the application as part of a lease/rental package requesting the use of water rights now held by the Idaho Water Company.

While this is Mr. Taylor's second notice of violation, it appears he is taking steps to correct the actions such that future irrigation is within an area authorized in some way by IDWR. Per the information submitted in the application package, the rental is for a single year while a transfer application will be submitted later this year as a permanent solution for the future seasons.

Authority to File: The application was prepared and submitted by Mr. Taylor. IDWR records indicate that he is the current water right holder and Power County records indicate he is also the current land owner. No concerns at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water rights being requested are now held by the Idaho Water Company, previously they had been owned by Mr. Kip Hunter and Ms. Brandi Hunter. The two rights, 35-2212 & 35-7147, are currently leased to the Bank and available for rent. No concerns at this time.

Injury Evaluation: No injury is apparent through this rental as it would appear Mr. Taylor is making an effort to correct unauthorized irrigation with a valid water right. Because Mr. Taylor is located within the Eastern Snake River Plain Aquifer modeling boundary, sufficient ETRAN modeling is required such that mitigation is not required through this rental. This modeling was provided in the application package and verified with the most current ETRAN model by the review staff. Based on the amounts requested, no mitigation is required and the review staff have no concerns at this time.

Enlargement of Use: Overall through this rental there does not appear to be a possibility of enlargement as the rental place of use does not feature existing water rights. No concerns at this time.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the rental.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster and IDWR Eastern Region comments were requested on

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Bank staff recommend the approval of this application for Mr. Taylor for a single year, through the end of 2020.
