





Dear Mr. Tuthill:

The Idaho Department of Fish and Game has reviewed the above referenced applications for new water rights from the Boise River and wishes to protest both applications, particularly the use of water during the critical winter period following the shutdown of irrigation systems. In our opinion, any further diversion of Boise River water during the winter period would be detrimental to both fish and wildlife resources.

The Department has a water storage right of 50,000 acre-feet in Lucky Peak Reservoir which is used to provide a maintenance flow in the Boise River for fish and wildlife during the winter months. Regardless of whether it is a surface or groundwater application, the public and the resources will be best served by leaving the water within the Boise River channel. It is important to note that the Department considers the typical winter flow of 150 cubic feet per second as a subsistence flow and not the optimum flow for fishery resources. We do not support any further diversion of Boise River water through subdivisions during the crucial winter season. The last six years of drought in southern Idaho have taken a toll on everyone from irrigators to natural resources and it has become apparent to us that the Boise River is fully appropriated.



Dear Mr. Tuthill,

On November 12, 1992, Rob Tiedeman and myself met with Scott Grunder and Stacey Gebhards of the Regional Fish and Game office to discuss our water right filing on the above permits.

At this meeting we were able to answer questions regarding Fish and Game concerns and discuss further our purpose for the permits. As a result of this meeting, the issues surrounding the protest have been resolved.

Two of the main issues of concern were the intended use and the year round nature of the application during potential lownow periods in the Boise River.

First, the intended use is to add supplemental water into an existing slough to allow revegetation of a 13-acre wildlife preserve set aside adjacent to the Boise River Greenbelt. The slough does not flow through the subdivision but rather through the Wildlife Preserve over which Fish and Game will have a Conservation Agreement.

Secondly, we have agreed to modify our application to limit our access to the water during the critical winter months.

In line with Fish and Game's desires, we hereby request our application be modified to limit our access to water from the Boise River to a minimum flow rate of 225 cubic feet per second or above. Since the intake facilities we plan to utilize are essentially dry at a flow rate between 225 and 250 cubic feet per second this will not impact our planned use of the water.

While we have plans to rebuild a portion of the intake facility, diversion at this point will be maintained to assure no water could be diverted by Wood Duck Island once the flow in the Boise River drops below 225 cubic feet per second.

Hopefully this will resolve the concerns of Fish and Game and the application can continue being processed.


### **MEMORANDUM**

RE: ANALYSIS OF PROPOSED SHALLOW WELL

DATE: 12\16\93

Per J. Johnson's request a simple analysis of the proposed well was conducted using Quickflow, an analytical 2D groundwater flow model. A steady state, flat water table model with a constant head linesink representing the Boise River was used to simulate the proposed well's potential drawdown and radius of influence. Aquifer properties are hypothetical. A depth of 14 feet was used to represent the available water in the well. Hydraulic conductivity (permeability on the data sheet) was set to constrain the maximum drawdown (i.e.— in the well) to 12 feet. This constraint resulted in a high value for conductivity (1350 ft/day). Therefore in the event that the actual hydraulic conductivity is less than 1350 ft/day it is possible that a deeper well will be necessary to produce 3 cfs. The analysis also shows that the radius of influence extends into the linesink representing the Boise River. This indicates the potential for direct surface water depletion from the Boise river by the pumping well.



Be sure to note the special condition requiring you to install a measuring device and lockable controlling works that will enable the watermaster to control the rate of diversion.


