Re: APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY WATER APPROPRIATION - SCARSELLA BROS.

Scarsella Bros., Inc. has applied for a temporary water appropriation 0.06 AF maximum daily withdrawal, total withdrawal of approximately 4.5 AF from the Palouse River for dust abatement and compaction of concrete for a highway construction project. The application states that the water is needed from August 1, 2007 to October 15, 2007 and from May 1 to May 31, 2008.

Fish and Game does not believe a proposed withdrawal maximum of 0.06 AF per day will have adverse impacts to fish, wildlife or habitat in the Palouse River. We recommend, however, that the permit clearly state that withdrawals may be made only during the 8/1 - 10/15/07 and 5/1 - 5/31/08 work windows specified in the application. At no time should the withdrawal reduce stream flows to below those needed to support beneficial uses.


