RE: Change in Ownership Water Right No. 27-2099

Dear Sir/Madam:

The Department of Water Resources acknowledges receipt of your Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership.

Our review of your notice indicates that additional information is required before we can process the change. The information required is indicated below:

- **** Evidence of Water Right Ownership: copy of Deed, or other legal document indicating your ownership of the property and/or water rights in question. Please note the current owner of the water right according to the records filed with the department is Carl Hayes. If you purchased the property from someone other than the current owner of the water right please submit copies of all the deeds going back to Carl Hayes. You can get copies of the deeds from the county recorder's office or you can try contacting your title company.
- **** **Filing Fee:** The filing fee for an ownership change is \$25.00 per water right for a non-split application or \$100.00 for an application that will result in a split.

Because the Department cannot process the ownership change without proper documentation/fees, we will hold any action on your notice pending receipt of the necessary information/fees. If we do not receive the necessary information/fees within 30 days we will return your notice and all attachments and your notice will not be processed.

Please note that Section 42-248, Idaho Code, requires you or the owner of this water right to maintain current ownership and address records on file with the department. Forms to file a change of ownership of a water right and/or a change in the address of the water right owner are available from any department office, or at the department's website at: <u>www.idwr.idaho.gov</u>.
