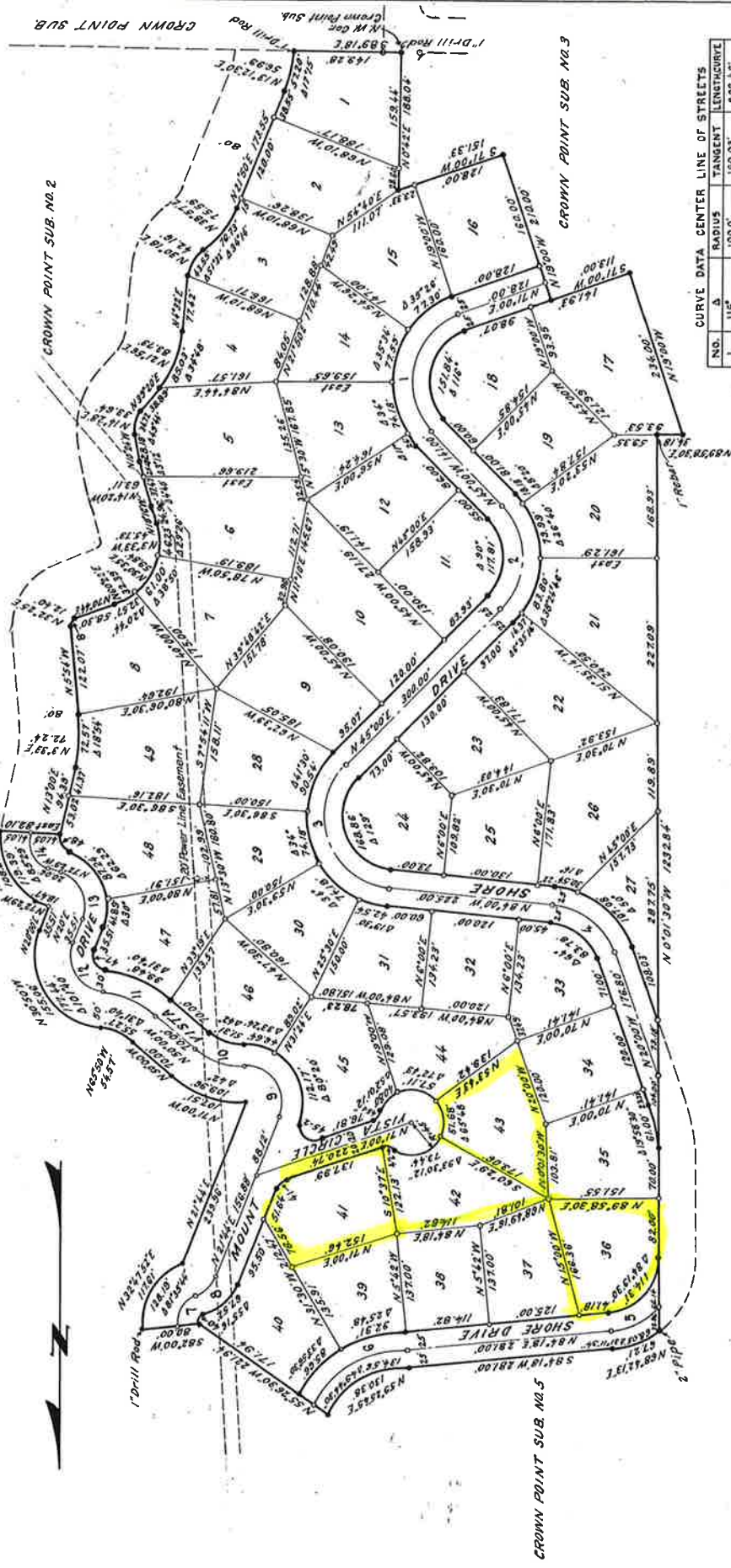

CURVE DATA CENTER LINE OF STREETS

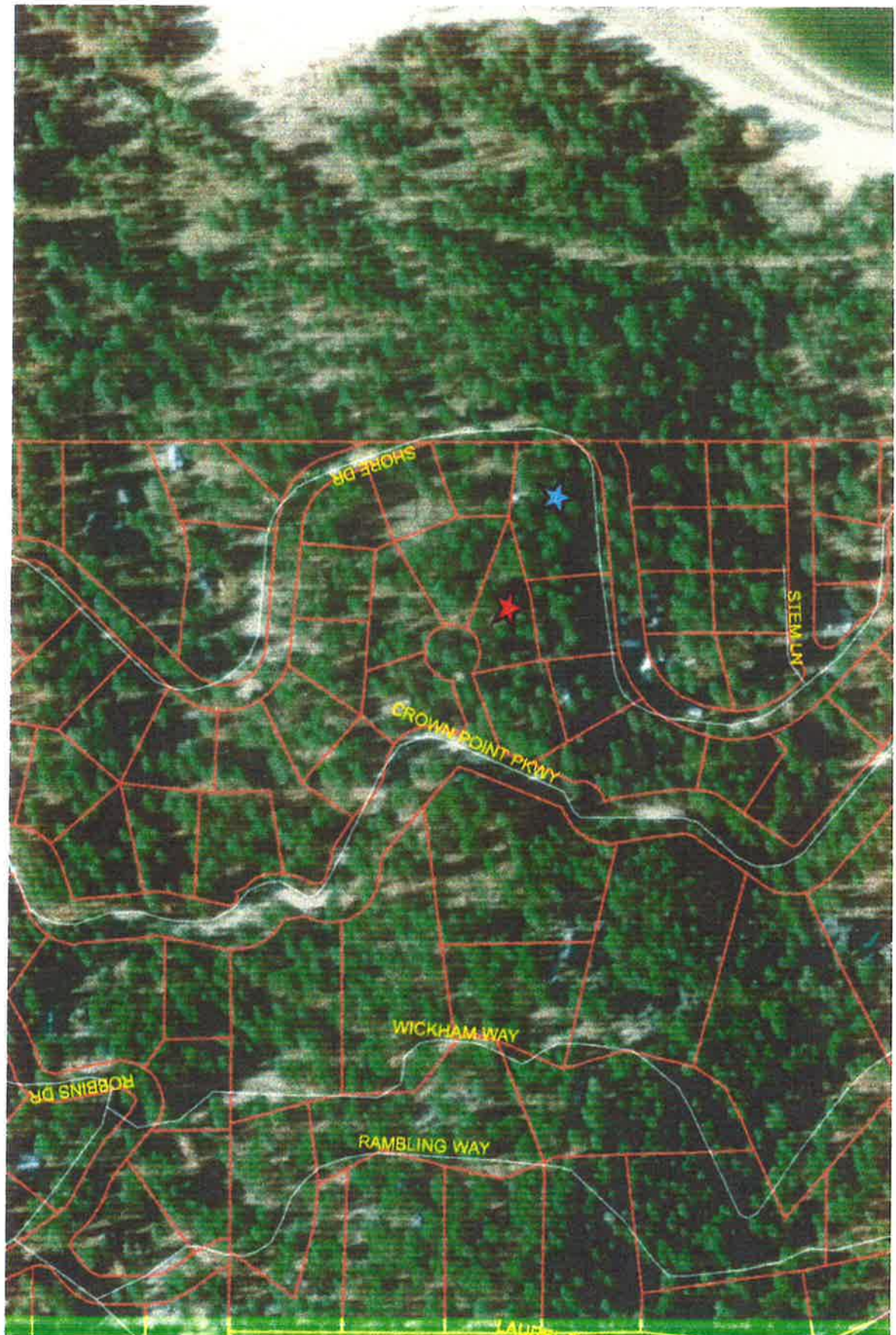

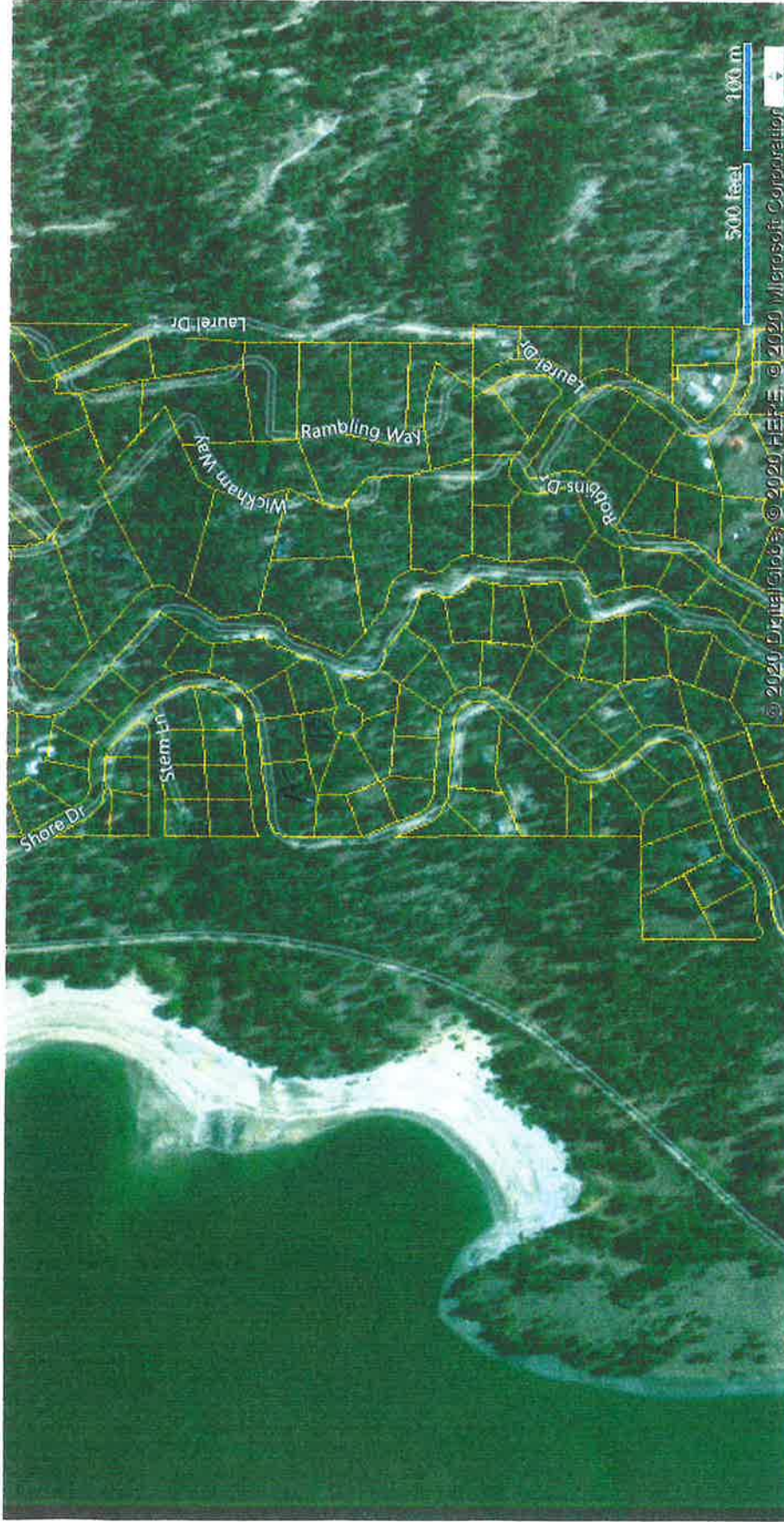

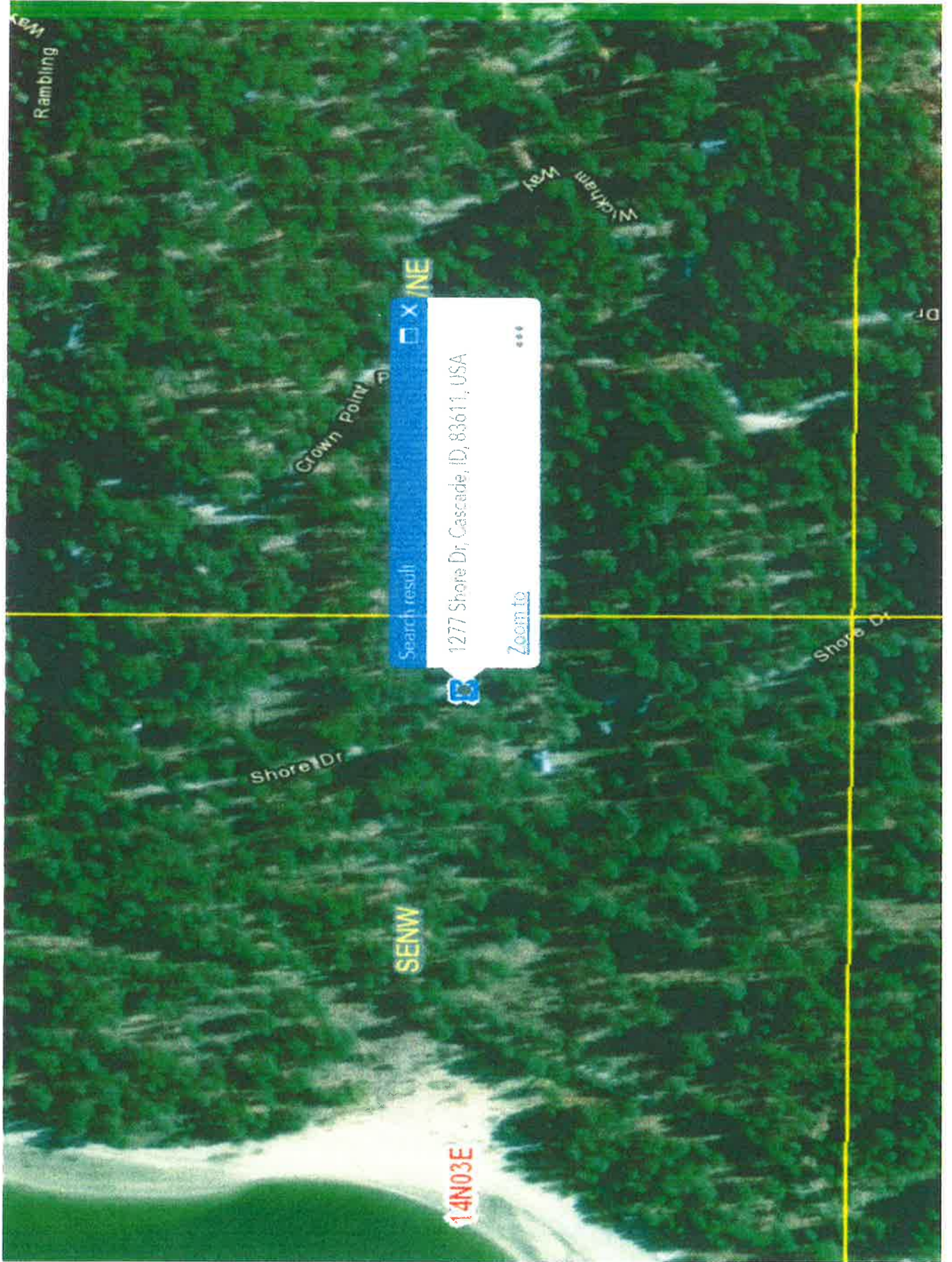
