

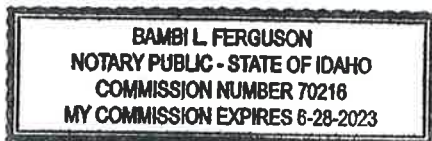

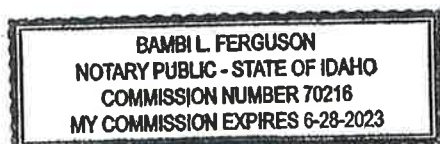

NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO AVOID FORFEITURE - ORANO USA LLC, 1155 F ST NW STE 800, WASHINGTON DC 20004, has filed an Extension of Time to Avoid Forfeiture for water right 35-13855, with a priority date of 02/14/1961 from groundwater in the amount of 0.76 cfs, 526.8 af, and 5 acres of irrigation. Water right 35-13855 was partially decreed on January 31, 2002. A 0.7 cfs portion of the water right is dedicated to mitigation by non-use.
