RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- The rented portions of rights 17-2052 and 17-7063 when combined shall not exceed the irrigation of 118.1 acres.
- 10. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 3.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.


- 11. The period of use for the irrigation under water right 17-7063 may be extended to a beginning date of 4/1 and an ending date of 10/31 provided that beneficial use of the water can be shown and other elements of the right are not exceeded. The use of water before 5/1 and after 9/15 is subordinate to all water rights having no subordinated early or late irrigation use and a priority date earlier than December 7, 2012.
- 12. After specific notification by the Department, the right holder shall install a suitable measuring device or shall enter into an agreement with the Department to use power records to determine the amount of water diverted and shall annually report the information to the Department.





2. <u>PROPERTY</u>: The Landlord leases to the Tenant the following described real property located in Oneida County, Idaho:

Approx'ly 120 acres in the NW 1/4 section 36T-14S,R-32E. (B2 Pivot)

- 3. <u>TERM:</u> The term of this Lease shall be for one (1) year, commencing January 1, 2020 and ending on December 31, 2020.
- **4. RENTAL AMOUNT:** The total rental amount will be \$15,000 to be paid by April 15, 2020.

Tenant plans to install a center pivot irrigation system and ancillary equipment on this property in 2019. All removable personal property that Tenant places on the property shall remain the property of the Tenant, both during and after the expiration of this lease.

5. **INSURANCE:** The Tenant shall provide liability insurance for injuries or damages occurring on the premises due to its negligence, acts or failure to act, and those of its employees, agents, and invitees.

The Tenant shall obtain and pay for insurance covering the irrigation system, and the Landlord will have no financial obligations relative to the center pivot irrigation system and ancillary equipment.

6. <u>IRRIGATION SYSTEM</u>: Tenant will be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the irrigation system that Tenant places on the property. Tenant will

be responsible for all repairs as well as all recommended preventative maintenance to the center pivot, irrigation well, pump, motor, pipeline, and associated electrical equipment.

Tenant will provide the water and will pay all power costs incurred in operating the irrigator on the land rented by the Tenant during the term of this lease.

Landlord will not be liable for any damages to the crop due to lack of water.

Tenant will provide all the water needed by the Landlord in the fall (at no cost to the Landlord) to establish a wheat (or other cover crop) on the acres planted to potatoes each year.

7. **FARMING PRACTICE:** Tenant agrees to farm the land according to the farming practices that are proper, standard, and accepted in the locality.

Tenant agrees to use only such seeds, fertilizers, herbicides, and other chemicals in such quantities and qualities as are proper, standard, federally labeled according to FIFRA, and accepted in the locality.

- **8.** <u>REAL ESTATE TAXES</u>: Landlord shall be responsible for payment of all real estate and personal property taxes and special assessments due on the property for the full term of this agreement and any extensions thereof.
- **9.** HERBICIDE DISCLOSURES: Landlord represents and warrants that all herbicides used on the Leased Premises during the prior three production seasons are set forth on attached Schedule A, and further represents and warrants that the rates, methods of application, and other information provided on Schedule A are truthful and accurate in all respects.

Re: Water Supply Bank Rental Application 1679 for Agreement 430

Purpose/Narrative: Application to rent water from the Water Supply Bank (Bank) was submitted by Greg Sullivan of Brockway Engineering on behalf of CSS Potato Farms and was received by the Department on March 10, 2020. This rental application was part of a package that included lease application 1663. The original lease offered a total of 125 acres between water rights (WR) 17-2052 and 17-7063 to lease into the Bank. The rental application originally proposed to rent the entire 125 acres, along with the associate rate and volume. Review of the lease rights revealed they only authorized 118.1 acres of irrigation in the quarter quarters described in the application. The lease was subsequently adjusted to meet this acreage. Review of the rental POU revealed it was also only 118.1 acres, and therefore the rental has been adjusted to rent the entire acreage available from lease of WRs 17-2052 and 17-7063.

Authority to File: The application was signed by Trent Munden, and supporting documents included a declaration signed by Reagan Grabner, managing partner for CSS Potato Farms, which provided signing authority to Trent Munden for all documents relating to water right applications. A review of CSS Farms annual report with the Idaho Secretary of State shows Reagan Grabner listed as a manager.

Parcel data available to the Department shows the land at the place of use (POU) and point of diversion (POD) as owned by Holbrook Farms, LLC. The rental application included a farm lease agreement between Holbrook Farms and CSS Potato Farms, granting CSS potato permissions to operate on these lands and utilize the irrigation system. There are no concerns over the authority to file.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: Right 17-2052 was licensed in 1973 and 17-7063 in 1983. These rights were consolidated in 2012 through transfer 78181 in order to increase the overall diversion rate and volume. This transfer limited the two rights combined to the irrigation of 316 acres, and authorized a diversion rate equal to 0.007 cfs per acre and volume of 2.1 acre feet per acre when combined. A portion of these rights have been leased to the Bank since 2017, and review of Climate Engine MAX NDVI data for 2015 and 2016 show clear signs of irrigation across the 316 acre POU in those years. No further concerns of water right validity.

Injury Evaluation/Rentability: This rental essentially proposes to move the 118.1 acre leased portion of these two rights to an adjacent field directly southeast of the leased acres. The same POD for the leased rights will be used for the rental. There are no concerns of injury to other water rights.

Enlargement of Use/Rentability: The application initially requested a total of 125 acres of irrigation, 57.4 acres from WR 17-2052 and 67.6 acres from WR 17-7063, however these water rights only authorize the irrigation of 118.1 acres in the QQs offered to the Bank. Additionally, the rental requested a diversion rate of 0.64 cfs for the 67.6 acres of 17-7063, which equaled 0.009 cfs per acres, however this right only authorizes 0.005 cfs per acre. The lease was adjusted to match the appropriate rate and acres and this rental was adjusted to the same. A total of 118.1 acres and rate of 0.605 cfs of 17-7063 was leased to the Bank, and a total of 54.2 acres and 0.183 cfs of 17-2052 was leased to the Bank. The rental will be adjusted

to include the entirety of subleased portions of these rights, and the selement will be conditioned so that the rental only authorizes the irrigation of 118.1 acres when both rights are combined.


During prior lease/rental reviews, the farm manager provided information explaining that the pivot from the idled field had been moved to the rental POU, essentially creating a field of the exact same size. There are no further concerns of enlargement.


Local Public Interest: There are no local public interest concerns
