Dear Permit Holder:

Enclosed is a copy of the denied request for extension of time which you submitted to the department in connection with the above referenced permit. Section 42-204, Idaho Code, provides that only one extension of time based on due diligence can be granted. Please note that one extension has already been granted on June 13, 1991 for due diligence.

Within one year of the time you actually intend to develop and beneficially use the water, I suggest that you file a new application. Since Idaho is now under a mandatory permit procedure to develop a water right, the new application will provide an additional period of time for development, although the priority date will be later in time. You should also be aware, however, that there is currently a moratorium in place which prohibits most new applications for permit. While the Department can accept your application, it is unlikely that it will be processed at this time.



ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-8145, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.

b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before June 1, 19 91.

c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.

d. The water right acquired under this permit if for hydropower purposes shall be junior and subordinate to all rights to the use of water, other than hydropower, within the State of Idaho that are initiated later in time than the priority of this permit and shall not give rise to any right or claim against any future rights to the use of water, other than hydropower, within the State of Idaho initiated later in time than the priority of this permit.

e. Other: Permit holder shall commence the excavation or construction of diverting works within one year of the date this permit is issued and shall proceed diligently until the project is complete.

The issuance of this permit in no way grants any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
