ENCLOSED IS A COPY OF YOUR APPROVED APPLICATION FOR PERMIT. WE DIRECT YOUR ATTENTION TO THE CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL ON THE FOURTH PAGE.

SECTION 42-235, IDAHO CODE, REQUIRES THAT A "DRILLING PERMIT" MUST BE OBTAINED FROM THE DEPARTMENT FOR ALL WELLS CONSTRUCTED AFTER JULY 1, 1987. A DRILLING PERMIT IS A SEPARATE PERMIT THAT MUST BE ISSUED IN ADDITION TO YOUR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER. COMMENCEMENT OF WELL CONSTRUCTION OR DIVERSION OF WATER UNDER YOUR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER IS PROHIBITED UNLESS A DRILLING PERMIT IS OBTAINED.

WE HAVE ENCLOSED A FORM ENTITLED "INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROOF OF BENEFICIAL USE". PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY SINCE YOU MUST TAKE FURTHER ACTION TO DEVELOP THIS PERMIT. ALSO ENCLOSED FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE IS THE STATEMENT OF BENEFICIAL USE FORM THAT MUST BE SUBMITTED WHEN YOUR PROJECT IS COMPLETED.

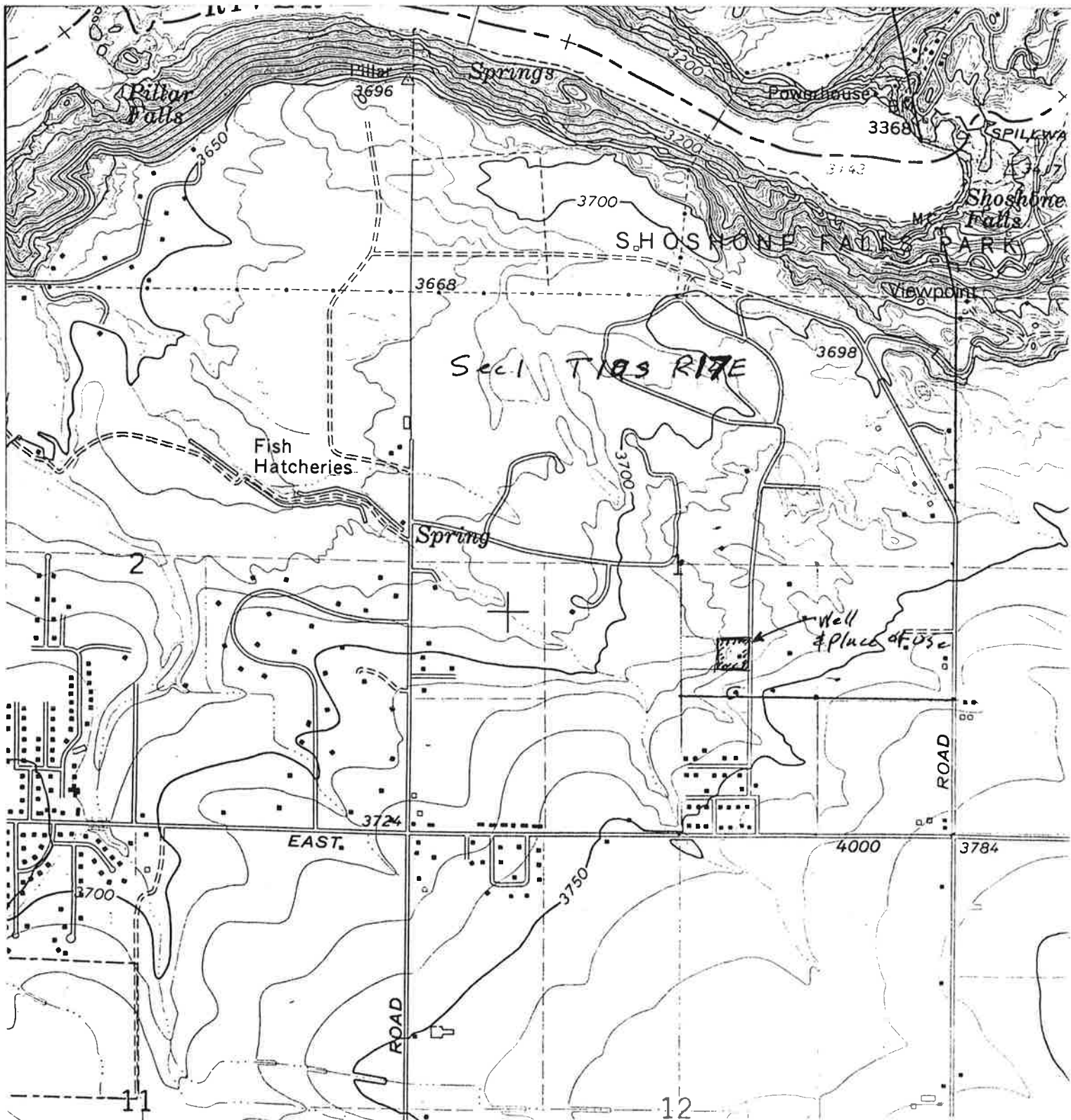

### ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-8071, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.

b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before December 1, 19 88.

c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.

d. The water right acquired under this permit if for hydropower purposes shall be junior and subordinate to all rights to the use of water, other than hydropower, within the State of Idaho that are initiated later in time than the priority of this permit and shall not give rise to any right or claim against any future rights to the use of water, other than hydropower, within the State of Idaho initiated later in time than the priority of this permit.


e. Other: Permit holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Section 42-235, Idaho Code.

The owner must submit a drilling prospectus for the construction of the well to the Department prior to drilling the well.

This permit authorizes the diversion and use of groundwater having a bottom hole temperature of less than 85°F.

The Director retains jurisdiction of this permit if water with a bottom hole temperature of 85°F or more is encountered.
