Dear Mr. Staples;

Our records show that both the above-referenced permit and the Snake River Basin Adjudication claim cover the same water system (your pump in a seep stream). The claim further states that you were not aware of the claim when you applied for the permit. The system was examined for the license in 1987, and I am attempting to complete the examiner's report. There is a problem, however. Since proof of beneficial use on this permit was submitted prior to the start of the Adjudication, we require that the permit be claimed in the Adjudication before the permit can be licensed. The permit has not been claimed, however. If you wish the license to be issued, the claim will need to be filed. If you prefer to go with the earlier claim on this pump (A47-04319), the permit can be relinquished via the enclosed form.

SRBA claims in Twin Falls County will not be reviewed for several years, so it is not possible at this time to say how the old claim might be recommended. In order for A47-04319 to be found valid, you will have to provide evidence supporting a priority date prior to May 25, 1971.


Dear Mr. & Mrs. Staples:

The Director of the Department of Water Resources has conditioned the approval of your application for permit to divert water on a written agreement with the Twin Falls Canal Company.

This will serve as the concurrence of the Twin Falls Canal Company in the approval of this permit under the following conditions.

- 1) The Twin Falls Canal Company considers the water developed by seep tunnels and drains as a part of the Canal System. However, in this instance the flow is situated such that further gravity irrigation within the tract is impractical.
- 2) The Twin Falls Canal Company does not guarantee the flow of this seep stream.
- 3) This is not to be considered as a precedent as diversion requests are evaluated on their own merits.
