Dear John:

Phil Rassier referred your note to me in connection with application for permit 47-8057 which was filed with the department on December 19, 1986. The application proposes a point of diversion in Sec. 14, T9S, R14E, B.M. which is not within the boundaries of the moratorium area designated by the Director in connection with the CSI suit. The point of diversion is, however, within the boundaries of the Banbury Hot Springs Groundwater Management area.

Rule 7. of the <u>Water Appropriation Rules and Regulations</u> relative to moratoriums, does not prevent an applicant from submitting an application for permit to the department. The rule authorizes the Director to cease approving applications rather than to prohibit the filing of an application. Applicants who file within a moratorium area should be advised by department staff of the moratorium and its implications.

If the Swan Falls settlement ever gets to the point that the department can again process applications which have been held, the department will need to carefully screen out applications within the boundaries of the moratorium area which seek the use of the thermal aquifer in order to comply with the moratorium order of the Director.

Dear Permit Holders:

Enclosed are copies of your approved Application for Permit Nos. 47-8055 and 47-8056. We direct your attention to the conditions of approval on the fourth pages of each permit. Please be advised that your plans for fish propagation under these two permits may be subject to regulations of the Idaho Department of Fish and Game. We suggest that you check with them before starting construction.

Note the requirement that as a permit holder you must commence the excavation or construction of diverting works within one year of the date the permits were issued, and you must proceed diligently until the projects are completed. The enclosed blue cards must be completed and returned to this office as soon as you commence construction, no later than one year from the date the permits were approved. We have enclosed a form entitled "Instructions for Proof of Beneficial Use". Please read the instructions carefully since you must take further action to develop these permits into licenses.

Also enclosed is your approved Request for Extension of Time within which to submit proof of beneficial use under Permit No. 47-7705. Note that the time has been extended to May 1, 1988 and the priority date of the right has been advanced to February 17, 1981.

Finally, enclosed is a Withdrawal Form for you to sign and return within 30 days, withdrawing Application for Permit No. 47-8057.

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Campbell:

The department's regional office in Twin Falls recently forwarded the above referenced applications for permit to this office for further consideration. A review of the applications shows that the intended use is to pre-use or re-use the water diverted under prior permits 47-7705 and 47-7562.

Upon checking the status of permit 47-7705, I note that you have submitted a request for extension of time which presently is before the department for consideration. Permit 47-7562, however, is being held for cancellation. On March 2, 1987, the department sent to Glaser Land and Livestock, Inc. (Glaser) an order to show cause why permit 47-7562 should not be cancelled. Glaser has not responded to the order.

The purpose of this letter is to request information relative to the ownership of permit 47-7562. i.e. whether Glaser owns the permit or whether you do. If you own the permit, please provide appropriate evidence of ownership to the department within fifteen (15) days, since the cancellation order of the permit is presently pending.

This permit is specifically limited to the use of the thermal water in that it can only be used when the water is being diverted under the other rights. If the other rights case to be used or fail to be licensed this permit will become void.


